Read **Romans 13:8-14** together.

Review

Paul calls his readers to remember the commandment to love their neighbor as themselves. With this one rule, they can reveal the love of Christ as they await the completion of God's work in redeeming his creation.

Discussion Questions

1. Paul quoted Jesus and Leviticus 19:18 when he wrote, "Love your neighbor as yourself." What does it mean to love our neighbors as ourselves? How do we participate in this type of love?
2. What can we clothe ourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ?
Help: Eph. 6:13-17
3. Paul tells his readers that "the hour has already come to wake from your slumber." What sort of "slumber" is Paul speaking about here, and what does waking from that slumber look like?
