Review

As Paul ends his letter to the church in Rome, he saves a considerable amount of space to greet various members of the congregation. While it may not mean much to us on first glance, it reminds us of the important truth that at the heart of the church is our relationships with one another.

Discussion Questions

1. What kind of relationship do you think Paul had with the people in this list and others he practiced his faith with?
2. Why would Paul be asking the Roman believers to accept Phoebe the deacon? What might her role be in all of this?
3. Does it encourage you to be participating in the same practical faith as the people in verse 5?
4. How might verse 20 be happening today and what is our part in it?
