THE FAITHFULNESS OF GOD

Read **Romans 14:1-23** together.

## Review

In chapter 14, Paul addresses the issue of voluntary dietary restrictions in the Roman community. However, at the heart of this issue is a question about existing in a community where everyone's ethics are not always on the same page: how do we act like Christ to one another when we disagree?

## Discussion Questions

1. As we grow and mature in our faith, how do we walk alongside other Christians who are at a different stage in their relationship with Jesus than we are?
2. Why do we often assume that if we disagree with another Christian on something that we must be the more mature ones? And how willing are you to have your mind changed by a brother or sister who offers a different perspective?
3. Paul says this about Christians who might practice their faith differently, "...for God has accepted them. Who are you to judge someone else's servant?" Does this affect how you see Christians who have different practices?
