Read **Romans 7:7-25** together.

Review

In Romans 7, Paul explains the state of the human condition--however, what he presents is the human condition before Christ. What this culminates in is what Paul has been leading to this whole time--we can't save ourselves, and neither can the Law. Only Christ, by giving us a new life, can change the state of the human condition.

Discussion Questions

1. In verse 7 Paul says that if it weren't for the law, he would not have known what sin was. What role did the Law play for the Israelites and the Judeans before the ministry of Jesus?
2. When is it hardest to do what is right? Why is it often hard to do what we know in our hearts is the right thing to do?
