Read **Romans 8:1-17** together.

Review

As Paul begins Romans 8, he shifts to the apex of the last few chapters: those who are in Christ Jesus face no condemnation, and are free from the consequences of Adam's sin and Death itself. Not only that, but we are invited to become co-heirs with Christ as God's children--participating in everything God has done in, for, and through Jesus.

Discussion Questions

1. How do we “who live according to the Spirit set (our) minds on the things of the Spirit”? How does that result in “life and peace”?
2. Has the Holy Spirit guided you towards righteousness in your own life? What is the difference between your current faith and your faith when you first became Christian?
3. What does it mean to be children of God? What does it mean to be a co-heir with Christ?
