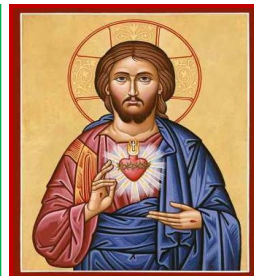

Pastor's Corner

Why Catholics Seek Mary's Intercession: A Biblical and Historical Perspective

In the Catholic faith and practice, the veneration of Mary, the mother of Jesus, holds a significant place. This devotion, often misunderstood or questioned, finds its roots deep within Sacred Scripture and the Apostolic Tradition of the Church. Here, we explore why Catholics seek Mary's intercession and how this practice is supported by both biblical references and historical precedent.



Biblical Foundations

From the Annunciation to her presence at the foot of the Cross, Mary's life is intricately woven into the fabric of salvation history. The Bible itself provides compelling reasons for Catholics to honor Mary. In Luke 1:48, Mary proclaims under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, "All generations shall call me blessed, for the Almighty has done great things for me." This verse encapsulates the scriptural basis for honoring Mary, she is acknowledged as blessed by God Himself.

Moreover, in Revelation 12:1, Mary is symbolically depicted as "a woman clothed with the sun," which has been traditionally interpreted as a reference to her Assumption into heaven. This imagery underscores her exalted role in the Church and in God's plan of salvation.

Additionally, the Bible teaches us about the communion of saints, where believers on earth and in heaven are interconnected through Christ. Hebrews 12:23 speaks of "the spirits of the righteous made perfect," indicating the ongoing spiritual connection between the Church on earth and the Church triumphant in heaven. Revelation 5:8 portrays the prayers of saints in heaven being presented to God, affirming their intercessory role.

Historical Development

The early Church Fathers, stewards of Apostolic Tradition, elucidated the role of Mary within the Church. St. Irenaeus of Lyons (+202 AD), for instance, referred to Mary as the "New Eve" whose obedience undid the disobedience of Eve, thus playing a pivotal role in the redemption of humanity through Christ.

From the fourth century onwards, Marian devotion became more pronounced, as reflected in the writings of St. Ephrem the Syrian and St. Ambrose of Milan. The Council of Ephesus in 431 AD formally recognized Mary as Theotokos, the Mother of God, affirming her unique role as the mother of Jesus Christ who is fully God and fully man.

Catholic Understanding and Practice

Central to Catholic belief is the concept of the communion of saints, which includes the belief that the saints in heaven can intercede for those on earth. Just as we ask our fellow Christians on earth to pray for us, Catholics believe in asking Mary and the saints to intercede on our behalf before God. This practice is rooted in the belief that those who have gone before us in faith are alive in Christ and can pray for us, as affirmed in Wisdom 3:1-6, which speaks of the souls of the righteous being in God's hand and at peace.

Conclusion

In summary, the Catholic devotion to Mary is deeply scriptural and historically grounded. It flows from the understanding of Mary's unique role in salvation history, her fiat that brought the Savior into the world, and her continued maternal care for the Church. As Catholics, we honor Mary not as a deity but as the foremost of the redeemed, whose life and example point us always to her Son, Jesus Christ. Through her intercession, we seek her prayers and guidance, confident in the spiritual bond that unites all believers across heaven and earth.

In embracing Mary's intercession, Catholics reaffirm their faith in the communion of saints, the richness of Apostolic Tradition, and the profound mysteries of God's plan for humanity. Mary stands as a beacon of faith and obedience, guiding us closer to Christ and reminding us of the abundant graces available through her Son, our Lord Jesus Christ.
