Pastor's Corner

The Sacrament of Confirmation

In the City of Saint Benedict, a group of young candidates eagerly prepared for their Confirmation. Among them was John, a spirited boy with a heart full of compassion. As he delved into the teachings of his faith, he found inspiration in the story of Pentecost, where the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles, empowering them to spread the message of Christ.



In the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the Sacrament of Confirmation is described as a sacrament that "confirms and strengthens baptismal grace" (CCC 1316). It's like adding fuel to the flame of faith. This resonated with John, who saw Confirmation as his chance to ignite his faith and share its warmth with others.

During the preparation, John learned about the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. He realized that these gifts were not just for personal growth but were meant to be shared for the greater good.

As John chose his confirmation name, he reflected on the saints who embodied these virtues. He chose the name Teresa, after St. Teresa of Calcutta, whose life of service deeply moved him.

Choosing a sponsor was another significant step. John chose his aunt, Philip, whose unwavering faith had always been a guiding light. Philip would walk beside him, offering support and encouragement as he embarked on this spiritual journey.

To all the candidates, John urged them to embrace the gifts they would receive, not just for themselves but for the betterment of humanity. He reminded them of their biblical roots, tracing the Sacrament of Confirmation back to Acts 2, where the apostles received the Holy Spirit.

As the day of Confirmation approached, John felt a sense of anticipation and joy. He knew that with the Holy Spirit guiding him, he could make a difference in the world around him.

In summary, the Sacrament of Confirmation is a powerful moment in a Catholic's life where they receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit to strengthen their faith and serve others. It's about embodying the teachings of Christ and spreading love and compassion in the world. Through choosing a confirmation name and a sponsor, candidates deepen their connection to their faith community and the saints who have gone before them, serving as inspirations and guides on their journey of faith.

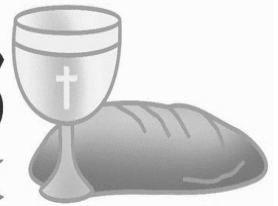
