Celebrating the Nativity Solemnity of John the Baptist

Dear Parishioners,

Monday this week, we joyfully celebrate the Nativity Solemnity of John the Baptist, the remarkable forerunner of our Lord Jesus Christ. His birth, foretold by the angel Gabriel to his parents

Elizabeth and Zechariah, was a miraculous event, occurring to an elderly and childless couple who had long prayed for a child.

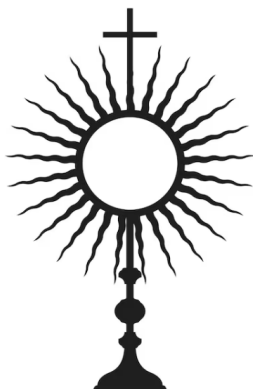
