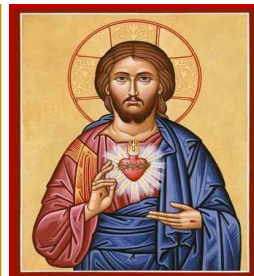

Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

As we reflect on the sacred event of the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ, we are drawn into the mystery of Christ's return to the divine realm. Scripture tells us that Christ, after offering a single sacrifice for sins, ascended above the highest heavens and now sits forever at God's right hand, as His majesty and might fill the skies.



The Ascension, described in the New Testament books of Acts and Luke, marks the end of Jesus' earthly ministry and the beginning of His heavenly reign. As Catholics, it signifies Christ's victory over death and His role as the eternal mediator between God and humanity.

Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus and His disciples gathered on Mount Olive near Jerusalem. There, Jesus promised His followers the Holy Spirit and instructed them to await His coming in Jerusalem. As He blessed them, He ascended into heaven, signifying the completion of His earthly mission and His return to the Father.

The Ascension isn't merely the end of Jesus' earthly journey; it's the fulfillment of God's plan of salvation. As Jesus returns to the Father, His human limitations come to an end, and His heavenly glory is restored. This moment also symbolizes Christ's exaltation by the Father, as He is given a name above every name.

In His parting words, Jesus assures us of His ongoing care and provision. He promises to prepare a place for us in His Father's house, where we will dwell with Him for eternity. This promise gives us hope and assurance, reminding us that our ultimate home is with Christ in heaven.

As we contemplate the Ascension of Our Lord, let us live with the assurance that Jesus is preparing a place for us and eagerly awaits our arrival. May we strive to live worthy lives on earth, anticipating the day when we will reign with Christ in glory.

Let us hold fast to our faith, believing in the promise of Jesus: "I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also."

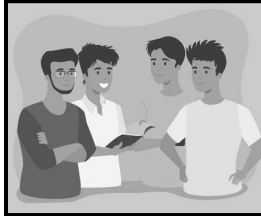
