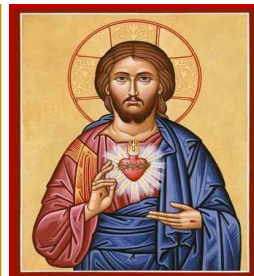

Pastor's Corner

The Most Holy Body And Blood Of Christ (Corpus Christi)

Corpus Christi, a solemnity deeply revered in the Catholic tradition, traces its origins back to the Last Supper, where Jesus instituted the Eucharist. As recorded in the New Testament, during this significant event, Jesus broke bread and shared wine with his apostles, symbolizing his body and blood. 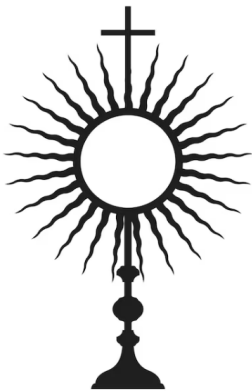
