Spotlight on Veterans

Ricky Sisneros- US Navy



Ricky was raised in Clovis and enlisted at the age of 21. He chose the Navy because he did not want to get stationed at Cannon Air Force Base in Clovis and he wanted to be near the ocean. He was running around with the wrong crowd and knew he needed to change. He also saw this as an opportunity to see the world. The Navy was appealing to him because 90% of naval bases are by the ocean. Ricky's older brother also joined the military service. In August of 1977, he reported to basic training in San Diego, CA. After Boot Camp, he flew to San Francisco, rode in a taxi cab to the ship and saw a massive carrier before his eyes. It was the USS Enterprise which was the first Nuclear Carrier and he asked himself, "Ricky, what have you done". In 1981, after 4 years of service, he decided to leave the military and return home to Clovis to be near his mother. He and two of his buddies all applied for jobs with the City of Clovis and the railroad. He had uncles and cousins who worked for the railroad. He got a job with the City of Clovis and returned to running around with the same crowd. After 90 days he realized he had to leave the same bad environment that he had left earlier and decided to re-enlist with the Navy though this made his mother sad.

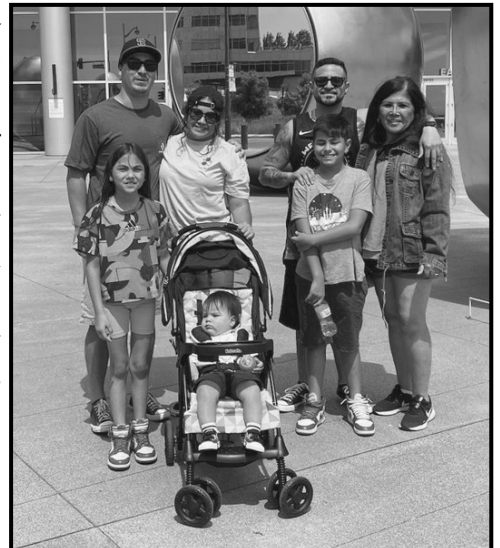
Ricky's deployments were to Hawaii, Hong Kong, South Korea, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and Australia and Japan for 8 years. He served in Operation Desert Storm and in the Liberation of Kuwait. While in Hawaii, he was on the Tiger Cruise. This is where family could come aboard, though no women were allowed at that time. Now that there are women serving on most ships, this has changed.

He was an Air Traffic Control Officer at Clark Air Force Base during his time in the Philippines. This is where he met his wife, Marjorie. She was a supply clerk and she was not interested in dating Ricky after their first date. They went on a second date and after two years of dating they were married. One year later, they had a son, Andy and were also blessed with a daughter, Yvonne. Yvonne is currently in the Air Force stationed in Qatar, her husband Jacob and children Oliver live in California and Ricky's son Andy has a daughter Isabella and a son Bentley who live in Clovis. Ricky is a very proud grandpa and babysits when needed.

A memorable time for Ricky was when he worked at Iwo Jima where he had a crew of 5. They would conduct operation drills for two weeks, then return to mainland Japan. During his time there, he climbed Mount Suribachi in Iwo Jima. In 1995 during a Memorial Day Celebration, an American flag that flew over Mount Suribachi was presented to Ricky for his service.

Ricky served for a total of 21 years and 9 months; his experience in the Navy taught him to appreciate America because it is the best country in the world. God is the foundation and prayer is powerful. Some challenges of entering the military are not being able to see your parents and kids as they age and being away from your siblings and parents during holidays and special occasions. He remembers using the Mar Station (Morris code) to call his wife on their anniversary. There was no FaceBook or FaceTime back then; it has become a blessing to keep in touch with loved ones.

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Ricky feels there is a need for more doctors to help Veterans; you can have a long wait to see a doctor. Your medical history while serving is very important and should be tracked in order to get the help you need, especially if it is full disability. The VA has been very helpful financially and Ricky is very grateful.

Ricky has volunteered at Sacred Heart Parish as an usher, lector and with the Food Pantry. He is a former Grand Knight for the Knights of Columbus. During his time with the K of C they were able to raise enough money, within two years, to fully fund the first ultra sound machine in Clovis for the Pregnancy Resource Center. He is active in the community and is in charge of the Red Arrow BINGO and serves as the Chaplin for the American Legion Post 25.

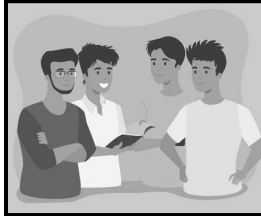
