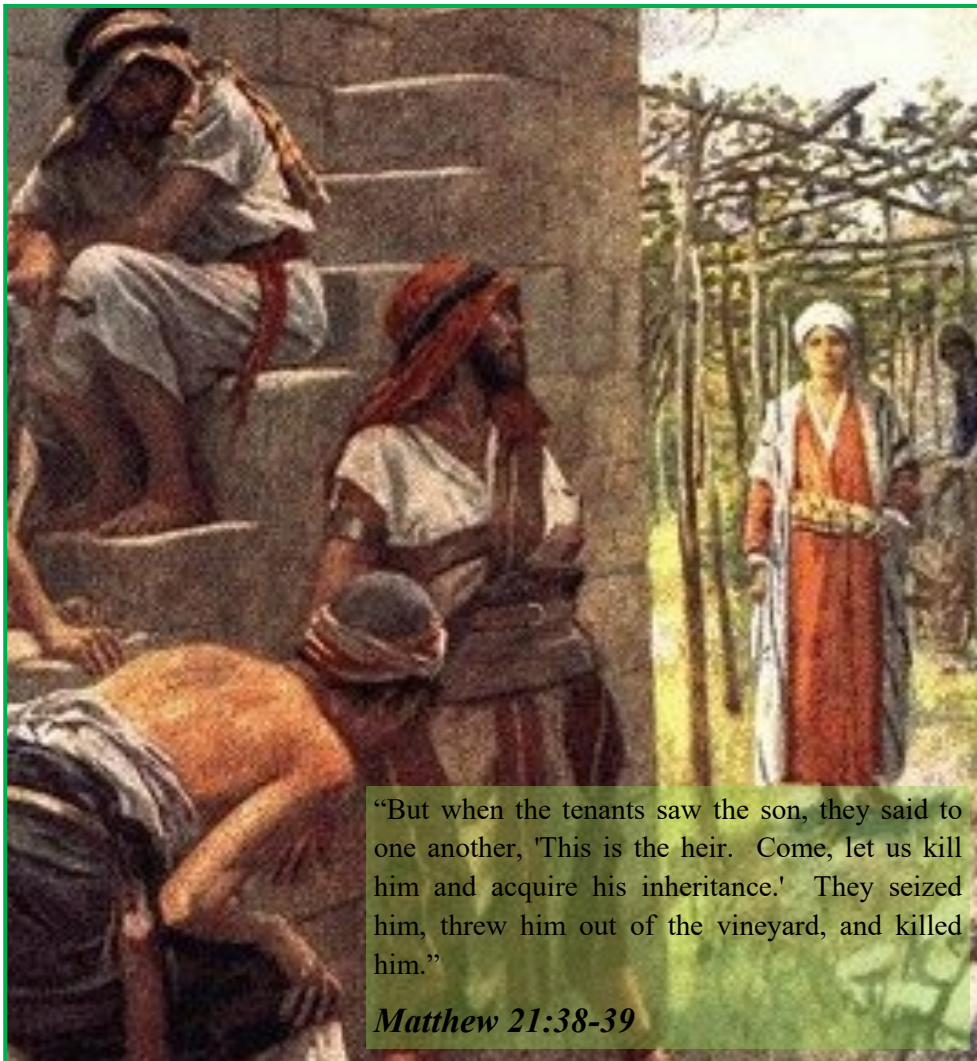

Spotlight on Veterans

Deacon Eric Arthur Nelson – U.S. Navy



Eric is part of a military family; his mother was a nurse in the U.S. Navy and his father, who specialized in N.B.C. (nuclear, biological, & chemical) warfare was in the U.S. Marine Corps for 21 years, both obtained combat veteran status, during the Vietnam War. Eric's sister, Jennifer, also served in the Navy in the electronics field.

After leaving the University of Texas at Austin's College of Engineering for financial reasons, Eric's mother encouraged him to join the service. Eric wanted to continue his college education and thought he could do that with the G.I. Bill. He enlisted in the spring of 1990. During his interview and reviewing his high ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) scores, they initially encouraged him to go into the Army's military intelligence linguistics

program. Eric was not interested in this field, so he turned it down and decided he wanted a challenge and heard that the Navy had the most difficult and interesting program to him; nuclear propulsion.

May of 1990, he went to Boot Camp and then attended Nuclear Field 'A' School and Naval Nuclear Power School at the Orlando Naval Training Center for a year and a half. After that, he attended a six-month long qualification training at the A1W prototype reactor at the Idaho National Engineer Laboratory. While in Orlando, Eric was nominated by the Secretary of the Navy to attend the prestigious Naval Academy in Annapolis, MD. He declined the nomination. He felt things were moving too fast and wasn't sure he could commit to ten more years of service. He completed his training in 1992 after the first Gulf War ended and was assigned to the USS California in Bremerton, W.A.. The nuclear-guided missile cruiser was docked for an overhaul.

Eric served 4 years and, under the Clinton administration, was offered an early out. He recalls that he felt proud and good about the country's mission during the Gulf War, even though the first time he left base, after boot camp, some people tossed eggs and yelled at him. Eric says that young people in the military are far from their family and friends, so often feel alone. Eric encourages people to stay in touch with military personnel by sending letters and making phone calls when possible. For those considering joining the military, he says figure out what YOU want to do and push for that career field. Do not let the recruiters sway your decision.

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Eric also believes today's veterans are different. More advancement in PTSD training is needed, and moral injury is real. Eric completed a class in moral injury and PTSD during his diaconate formation and the class was designed to increase participant's knowledge of trauma, moral distress and moral injury, drawing from research and work in various disciplines. These disciplines include the fields of social work, psychology, spiritual care, mental health counseling, and religion. The VA currently does not help, very well, one to recover spiritually when their core beliefs and conscience take a beating from military service.

Eric is a Deacon at Sacred Heart Parish, provides tech support for the church, is a 4th degree member of the Knights of Columbus, visits the homebound and is starting up a prison ministry.
