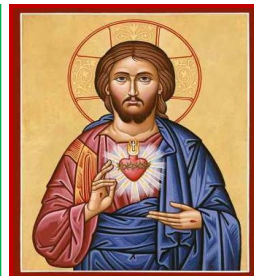

Celebrating the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Dear Parish Family,

On September 14th, we gather to celebrate one of the most profound and sacred feasts of the Christian calendar: The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. This day invites us to reflect on the cross not merely as a symbol of suffering, but as a beacon of hope and redemption.

The Significance of the Feast

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross commemorates the dedication of the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem by Emperor Constantine in 335 AD. This church was built on the site believed to be where Christ was crucified and buried, marking the moment when the cross, once a symbol of shame and execution, became a central emblem of our salvation.
