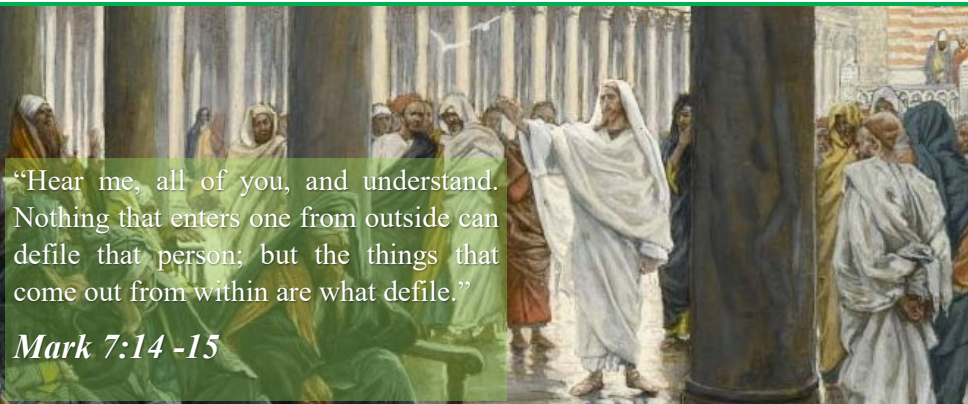

Celebrating the Feast of St. Monica - A Lesson in Perseverance and Faith

Dear Parish Family,

On August 27th, we celebrated the feast of St. Monica, a remarkable woman whose life offers us a profound lesson in the power of persistent faith and unwavering prayer. St. Monica, the mother of St. Augustine, is renowned for her extraordinary perseverance amid deep personal and familial trials.
