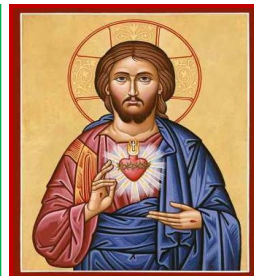

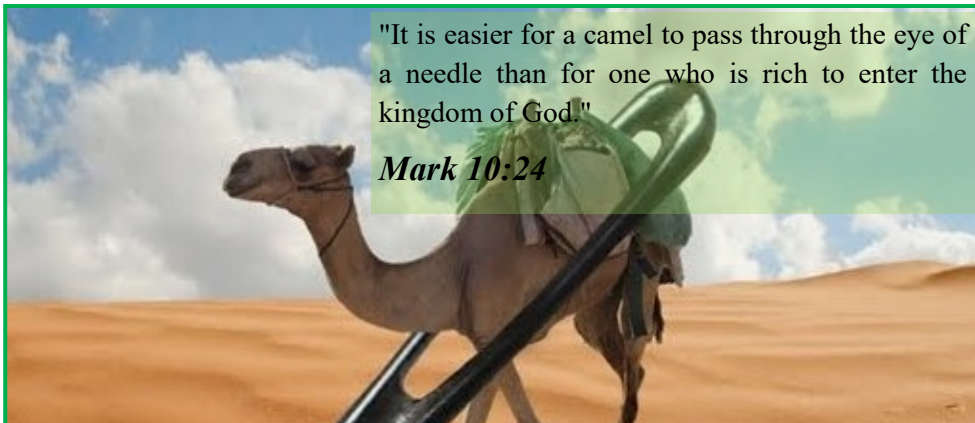

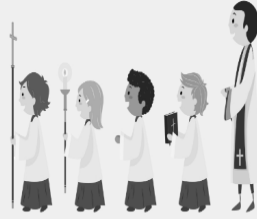
Pastor's Corner

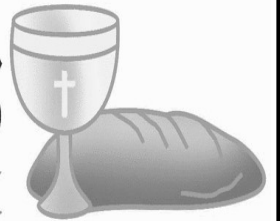
