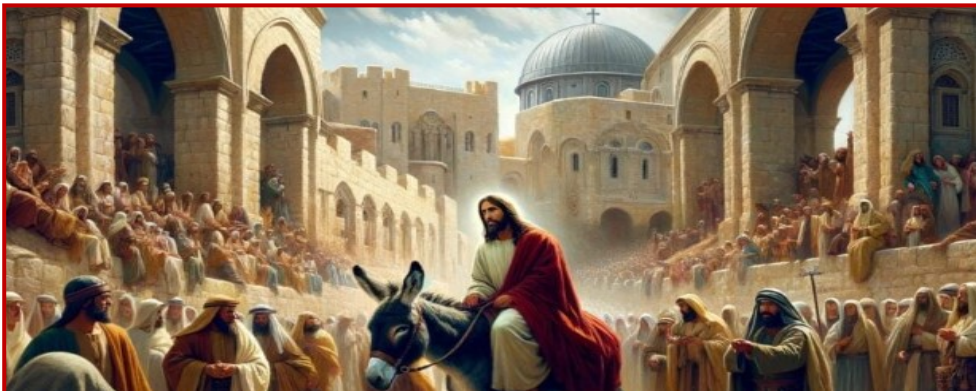

## **Holy Week: A Time of Solemn Reflection and Celebration**

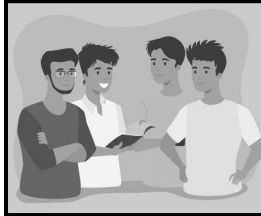
