Pastor's Corner

Remembering Our Church Through Offering, Tithing, and Grace Giving This Lenten Season



Dear Parishioners,

As we journey through the season of Lent, a time of reflection, repentance, and preparation for Easter, it is crucial that we turn our hearts and minds towards the essence of sacrifice and giving, both in our spiritual lives and within our community. In the liturgy of the Eucharist, we witness the profound act of Thanksgiving, as Eucharistic, derived from the Greek word *εὐχαριστία* (*eucharistia*), signifies precisely that – giving thanks.

Just as the bread and wine are brought forward in the Eucharistic celebration, symbolizing the entirety of our lives, possessions, and efforts, so too do we bring forward our offerings, representing all that we are and all that we have received from God. It's a reminder that our contributions during Mass, including our financial offerings, are part of the sacrifice we collectively make as a community.

St. Cyprian, in the third century, reminded us of the importance of offering during the celebration of the Eucharist. He admonished those who partook in the Lord's Supper without making their own sacrifice, reflecting on the story of the widow's mite from the Gospel.

During this Lenten season, as we focus on almsgiving and caring for the least among us, let us not forget the importance of supporting our parish. We are stewards of God's blessings, entrusted with the responsibility to serve Him and contribute to the flourishing of our Church. Our parish relies on our generosity to maintain our sacred spaces and support our ministries.

It is with this in mind that I urge you to consider contributing to our parish through the Sunday envelope or online via the PushPay app. Your donations go a long way in supporting our ongoing maintenance efforts for our aging school and church buildings.

Reflecting on the ancient practices of offering, tithing, and grace giving, we see how these acts have been integral to the worship and devotion of God's people throughout history. From Cain and Abel to Noah and Abraham, sacrificial giving has been a central aspect of our relationship with God.

Tithing, as instructed in the Old Testament, was an act of worship and dedication, symbolizing the giving of a portion of one's income or produce to honor God. Similarly, freewill offerings allowed for voluntary expressions of devotion and gratitude.

As we consider these traditions, let us remember that our contributions to the church are not just financial transactions but acts of worship and thanksgiving. They enable us to participate actively in the mission of our parish and fulfill our call to stewardship.

Let this Lenten season be a time of renewal and recommitment to supporting our parish community. Together, through our offerings, tithing, and grace giving, we can ensure that our church remains a beacon of faith, hope, and love for generations to come.

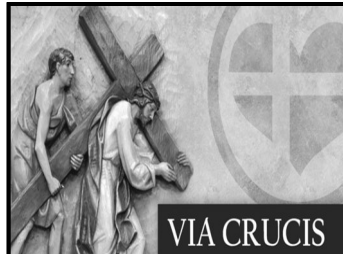
