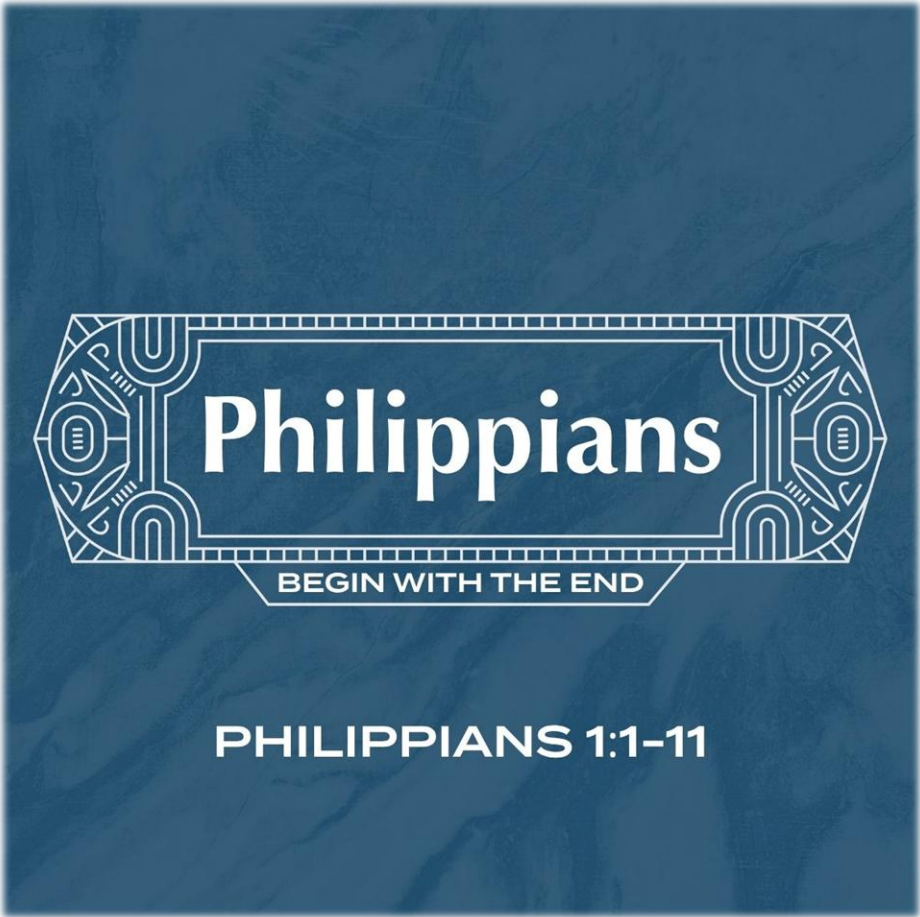
Upcoming Events
