Homebound Ministry

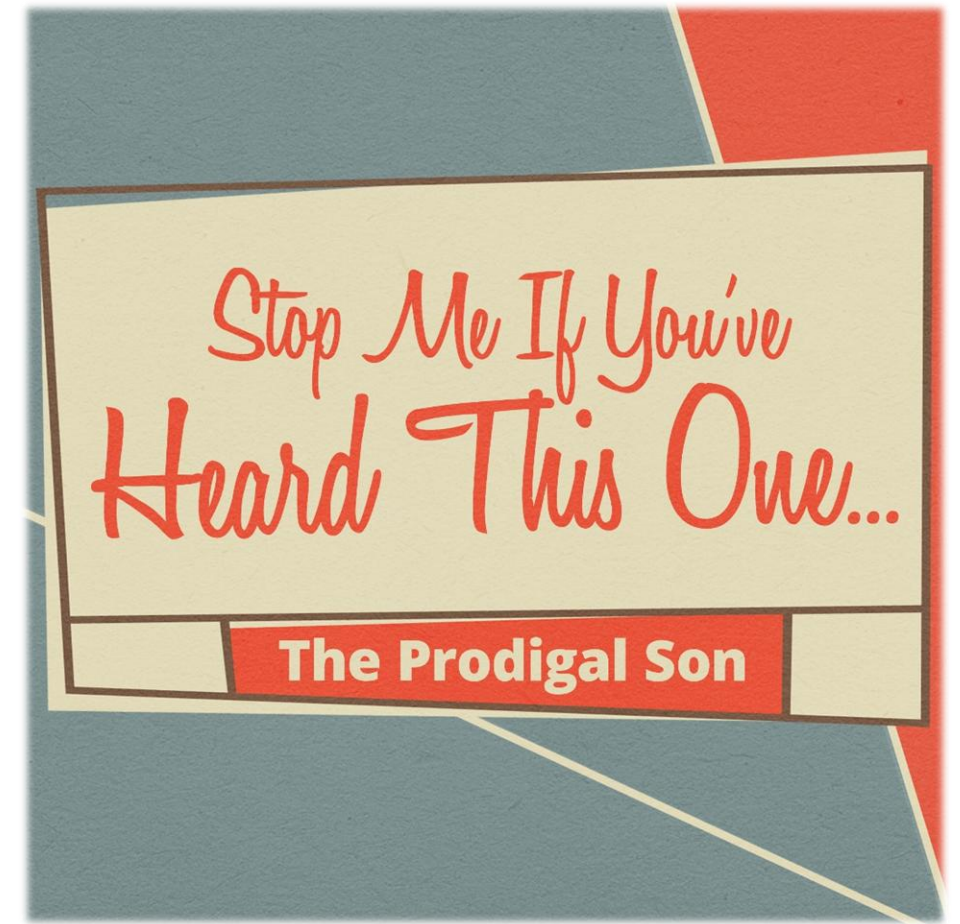
