Join Our Panther Prayer Team

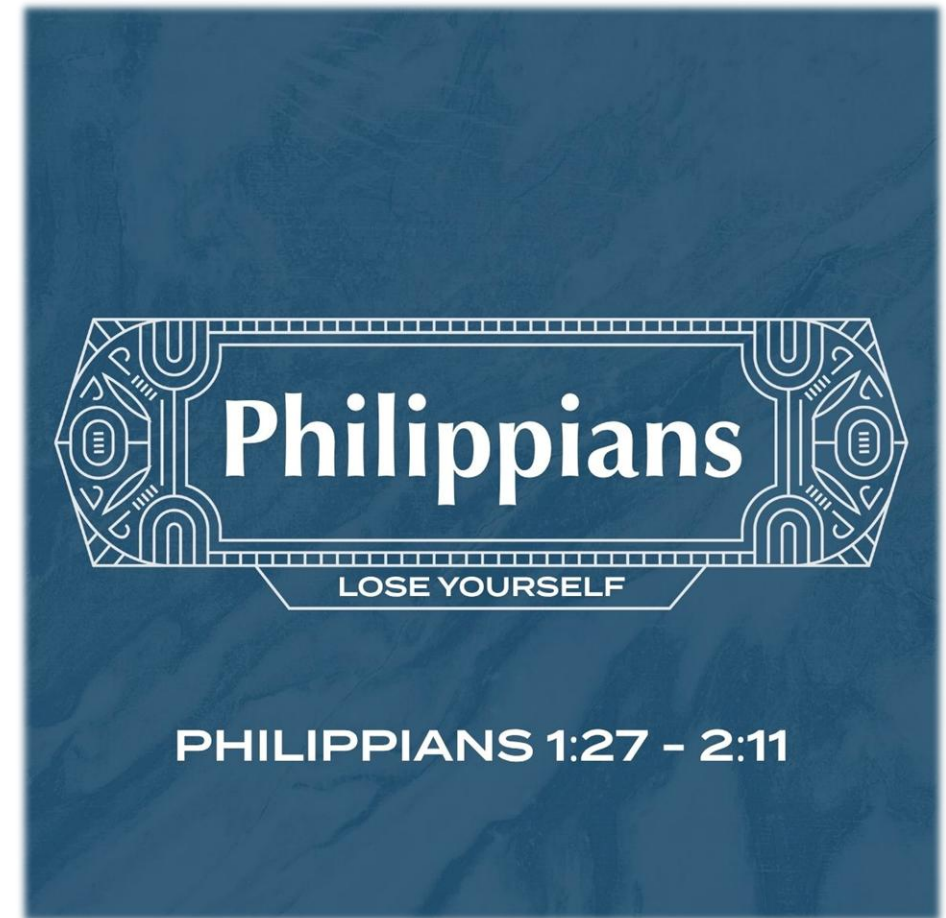
