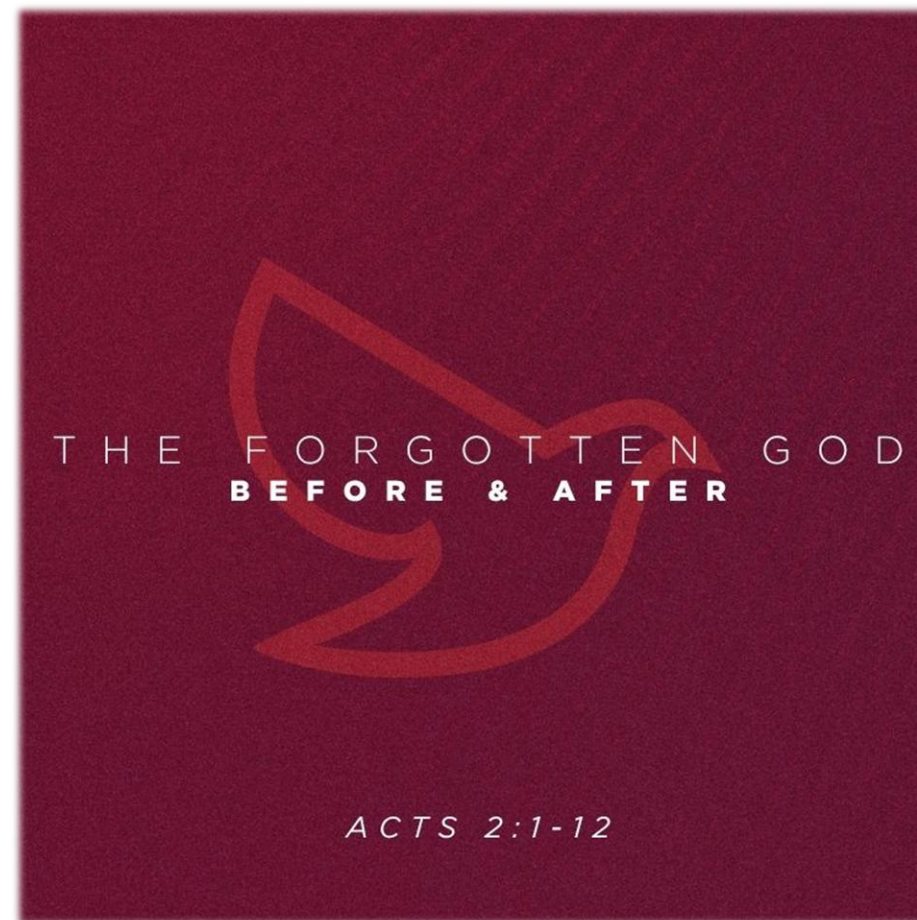
Baptism | June 7 @ 6:00pm
