A huge thank you as well to **Carey Dallas**, who led us in worship through song during the service. Carey did an incredible job, and I couldn't have been prouder of her.

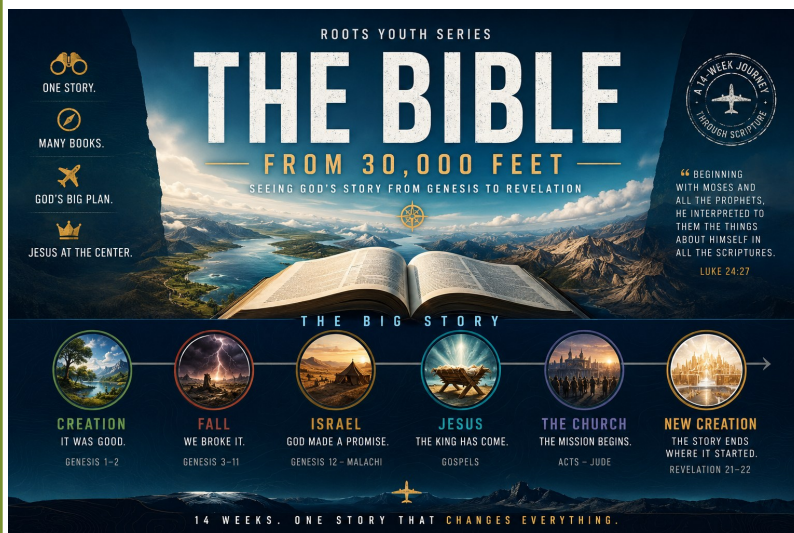
Then came VBS.

I also have to brag on our youth for a minute. Once again, they showed up ready to serve. Whether it was helping with activities, leading younger kids, cleaning up, encouraging others, or showing off dance moves that should probably stay at VBS, they represented Fairview incredibly well.

Watching our students serve others is one of my favorite things because it reminds me that they aren't just the future of the church—they're already a valuable part of the church right now.



This summer our youth have started a new series called "**The Bible From 30,000 Feet: Seeing God's Story from Genesis to Revelation.**"

Most of us know a lot of Bible stories. We know about Noah, David, Jonah, Daniel, Peter, and Paul. But sometimes we can miss how all those stories connect together.

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The Bible isn't a collection of random stories about random people. It's one story telling us about one God and His plan to redeem the world through Jesus Christ.

Over the summer we're taking a step back and looking at the big picture. We're walking through the entire Bible and seeing how every chapter, every covenant, every promise, and every story points us to Jesus. My prayer is that our students won't just learn more information, but that they'll leave with a deeper understanding of God's Word and a greater confidence in the God who wrote it.

As we head into July, I've been thinking about something Paul wrote in Romans 15:13:

"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit."

That's such a needed reminder because sometimes life can feel like it's moving at a hundred miles an hour. Before long school will start back, football season will be here, and somebody will probably start putting Christmas decorations out before we're emotionally prepared for that conversation.

But in the middle of all the busyness, God remains the same.

The same God who was faithful yesterday will be faithful tomorrow. The same God who carried you through difficult seasons before will carry you through whatever comes next. So take time this month to slow down, enjoy your family, make some memories, and most importantly, spend time with the Lord.

And if you happen to see one of our youth students teaching VBS dance moves to someone in the church hallway... just know we've done everything we can.
