Mission: GIVE Update

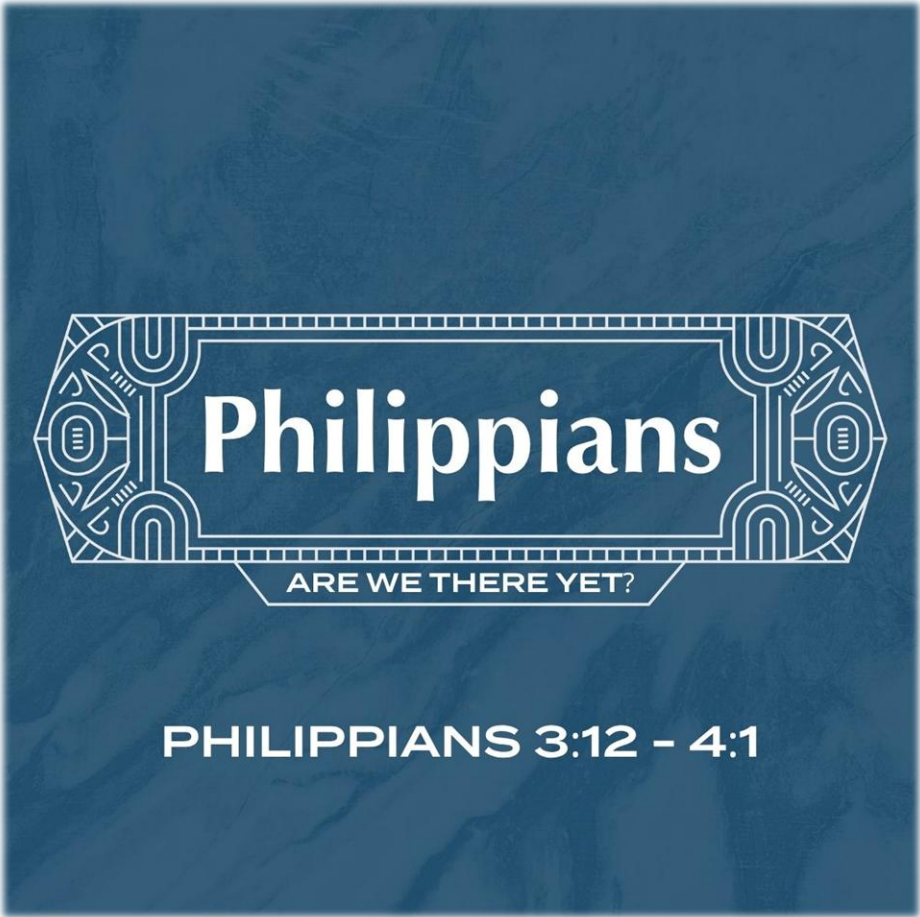
