Word of the Year: Resilience

In 2026, we believe God is forming a steady, faithful strength in us.

A strength that shows up in ministry, generosity, and trust.

Our anchor is 2 Corinthians 4:8–9. Pressed but not crushed. Struck down but not destroyed.

This vision is simple and rooted in who we are as a church that builds bridges to new life.

1. Resilience in Ministry

We begin the year with 21 days of consecration.

We are asking God for fresh focus, renewed hunger, repentance, and a restored sense of calling.

A major focus of 2026 is raising up people for the work of ministry.

We believe God is calling us to identify and develop **26 emerging leaders** in areas like:

- Care and visitation - Community chaplaincy - Ministry teams - Teaching and preaching

We are also believing God for **26 baptisms** this year.

2. Resilience in Generosity

This year we plan to pay off the remaining **58,000 dollars** of church debt.

This is not just financial. It is spiritual resilience and freedom.

We will continue building financial reserves and preparing for future facility needs.

We also plan to give away household goods, food, and supplies as God provides.

A key goal for 2026 is to serve **26 community projects**, allowing BCC to make a consistent impact throughout Henry County.

3. Resilience in Trust

We will finish the discernment process related to selling our current facility and relocating if God confirms the direction.

This will require courage, unity, and patience.

We will hold our plans with open hands and listen carefully for God's leading.



We are also exploring new ministry areas such as:

- Support groups for practical and spiritual needs
- Community chaplaincy
- Building an online church expression

All of this is about being faithful where God places us.

4. Supporting Focus Areas for 2026

To walk out this vision, we will strengthen three key areas:

Hospitality

Every partner helps make room for new people. We want youth, young adults, and guests to feel seen and valued.

Volunteer Care

Our ministry depends on healthy volunteers. We are committed to supporting, encouraging, and appreciating our teams throughout the year.

Pathway to Serve

We are building a clear path that helps people move from attender to servant leader. This pathway is essential for raising up 26 new leaders.

What We Are Asking of Partners

- Pray daily for the 21 days of consecration
- Pray for 26 leaders and 26 baptisms
- Pray for wisdom in the facility decision
- Step into serving or leading if God prompts you
- Support the debt payoff and generosity goals
- Be intentional in welcoming and caring for people
- Join in serving our community throughout the year
