Just like American children, the students at the Neshuro Caring Center (NCC) are **looking forward to celebrating** the birth of Jesus on Christmas day.

Unlike American children this year, the students at NCC are **feeling the effects of the severe drought** facing large portions of Africa, including Zimbabwe.

The NCC farm leases most of the land to cattle farmers and then plants crops on the other portion of the land to help feed the students. With the functional well and solar generator, a small crop was harvested and the cattle are surviving. The **drought is predicted to continue** into spring 2025.
