### SUMMER TEEN INTENSIVE

Looking for a challenge this summer? Ready to strengthen your craft? If you're excelling in your school theatre department and looking for a challenge, this two-week conservatory-style intensive is crafted to elevate your performance skills and prepare you for a serious path in theatre and film. Modeled after top college acting programs, this experience is open to high school sophomores, juniors, and seniors. Led by professional artists from the Denver Center for the Performing Arts, students will strengthen their craft through focused training in acting technique, character development, voice and movement, and text analysis.
