

We are Called To ...

- **March 17 - More Service with Embrace Grace (Psalm 34:18 MSG)**

We've all had a moment where our life has been laid bare before the world, moments where we've been knocked down and are scared. As followers of our Lord, we know He is there for us, but there are many who don't know He's watching over them, even when it feels like no one cares. Many feel they can't handle the next step because they lack support. Today, we pray for all Embrace Grace participants, past and future, and ask that He guide us in showing these women and their precious children His love.

- **March 18 - More Service in FriendSpeak (Leviticus 19:33-34)**

We have an incredible blessing that most Christians don't get to enjoy: the world is coming to our doorstep. The Lord showed kindness to our forefathers in the faith when they were strangers in Egypt and Babylon. As He showed love to us, we are to show love to all who are coming to our area. Today, ask the Lord to send us more people whom we can help through the FriendSpeak ministry, and ask the Lord to raise up more than enough workers to minister to the thousands coming to our doorsteps.

- **March 19 - More Service in Children's Classes (Proverbs 22:6 and Psalm 127)**

We are so blessed to have services that are full of cries, squeals, and loud whispers. The Lord has truly blessed this family with children. Today, we thank Him for those who devote their time to help raise other children to know the Lord. This is an area of service that is often overlooked but offers incredible rewards. Take some time today to ask the Lord to continue raising up teachers willing to train our children, and to continue blessing this family with more children.

- **March 20 - More Service in DivorceCare (Psalm 147)**

Praise the Lord for being so gracious to us, we are a broken, wounded people whom He knew needed healing. Some of these wounds are deeper than others, and sometimes those injuries need to be tended to. Today, we ask the Lord to continue to heal those who need healing and strengthen those going through hard times. Continue to let this body be a place of refuge and healing for those who need it.

- **March 21 - Open Our Eyes to Whom God Would Have Us Serve (Psalm 146)**

There is always a place to serve and people who need to be served. Just because we don't see the need doesn't mean it's not there. Our Lord knows who needs help and how they need it. Today, let's ask the Lord to open our eyes to the areas where we have been blind up to this point and to show us how to serve as He wants them served.

- **March 22 More Outreach at Main Street Church of Christ (Isaiah 58:7 and Matthew 25:35-40)**

Our brothers and sisters at the Main Street church in Dallas are serving the least of these daily. Meals are cooked, and love is shown every day of the week. Currently, we go down once a month to feed and fellowship with those whom the world ignores. Today, let's ask the Lord to continue to bless the Main Street church and their work, and let it drive us to see all those people who hide away in the nooks and crannies of Collin County and determine how we can serve Jesus by serving them.

- **March 23 More Outreach at McDermott Road Preschool (Matthew 19:13-15)**

The song is right, Jesus loves the little children; He shows such care and tenderness to them every time He comes into contact with them. Our Preschool is doing incredible work in showing Jesus to kids who otherwise may not see Him. Today let's ask the Lord to bless the teachers who show Jesus to these kids and ask that He bless this ministry and let it grow into even more of an impact in our community.
