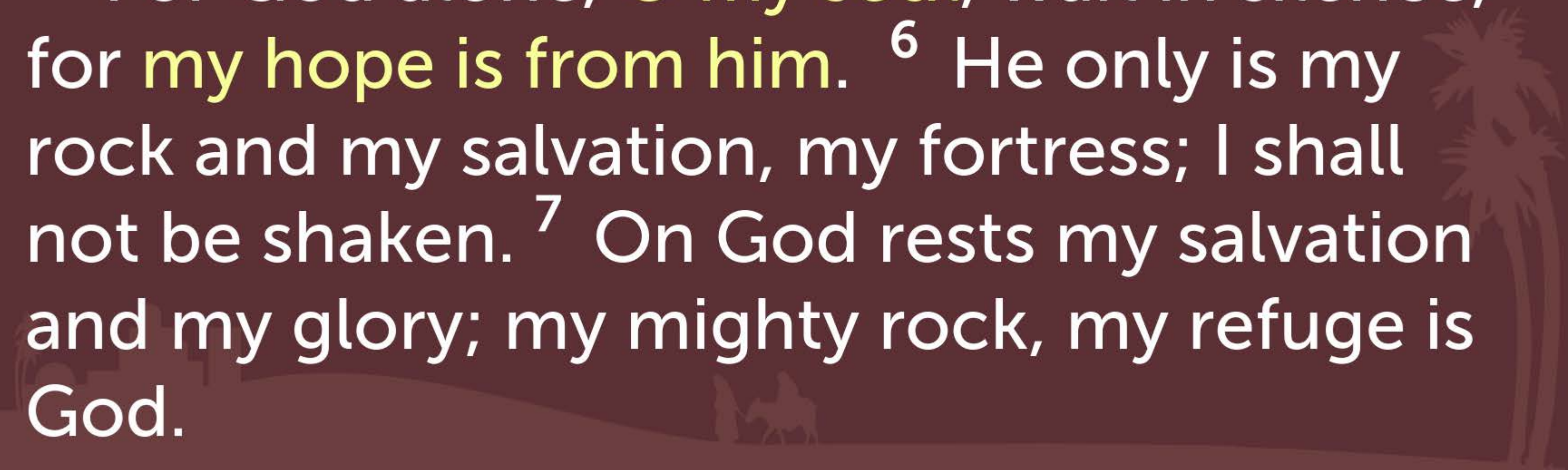

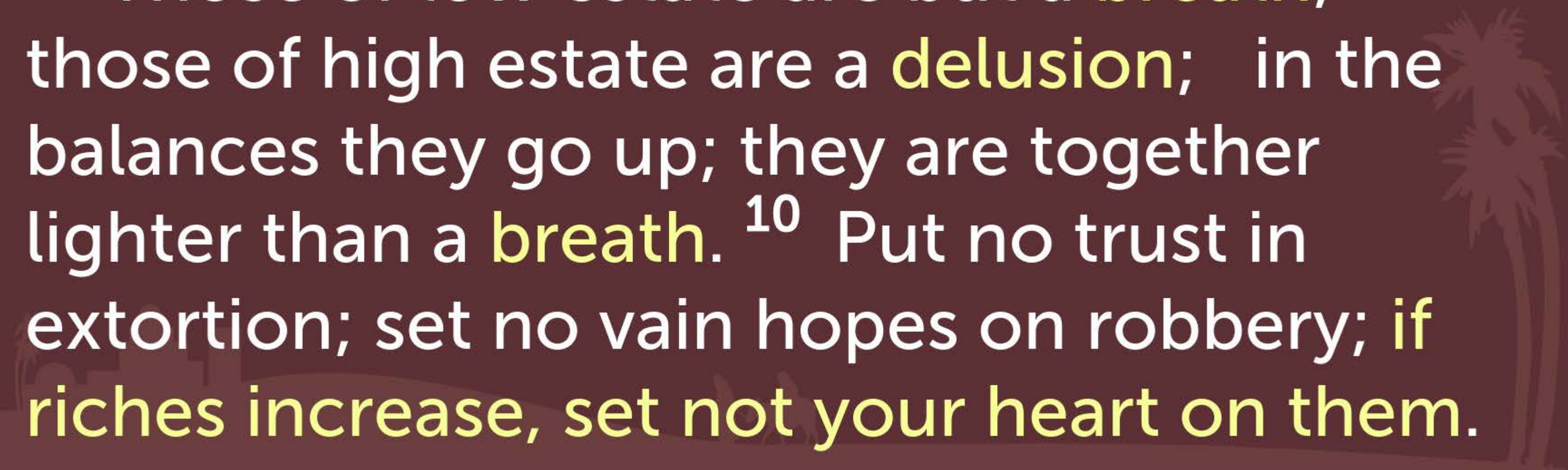
⁸ Trust in him at all times, **O people**; pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us. *Selah*
