

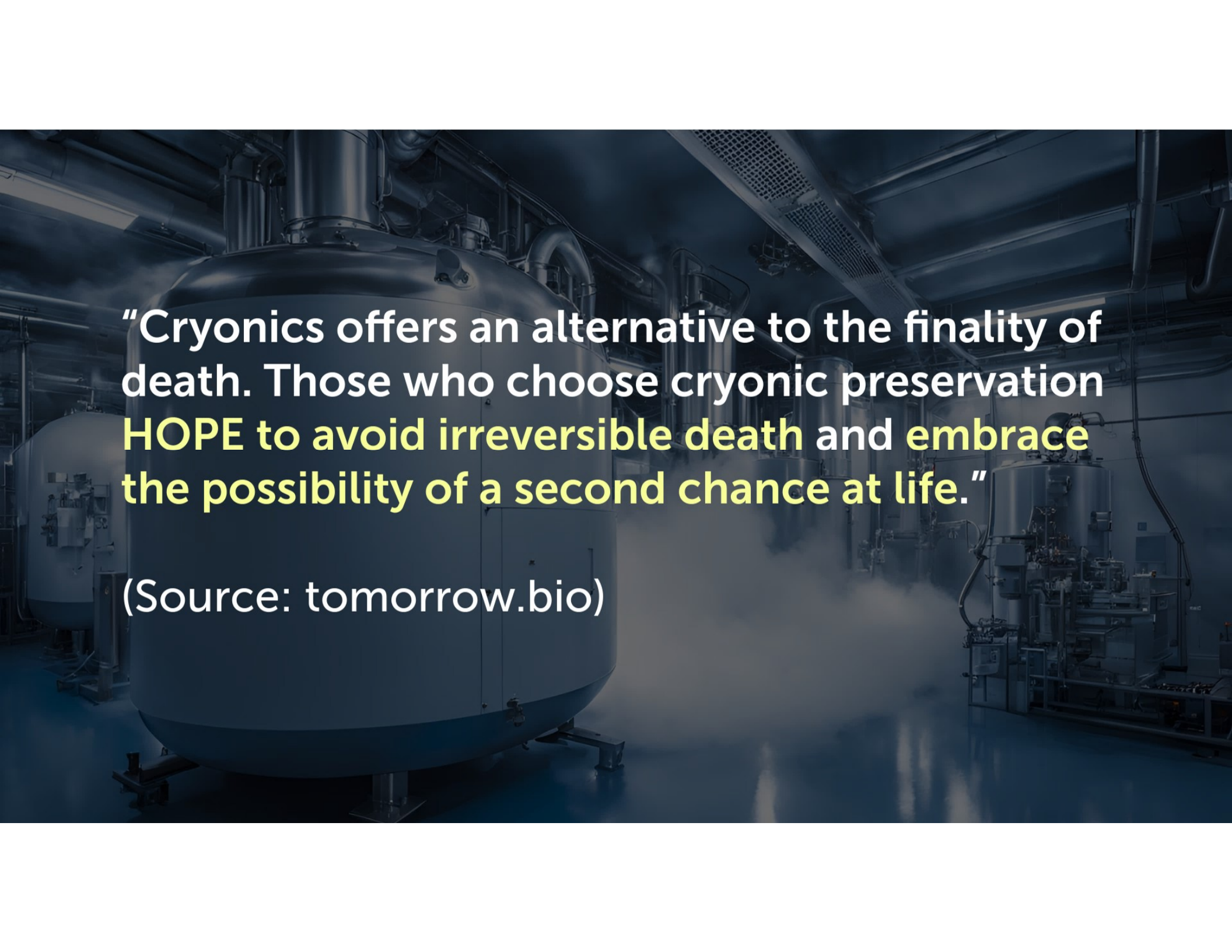

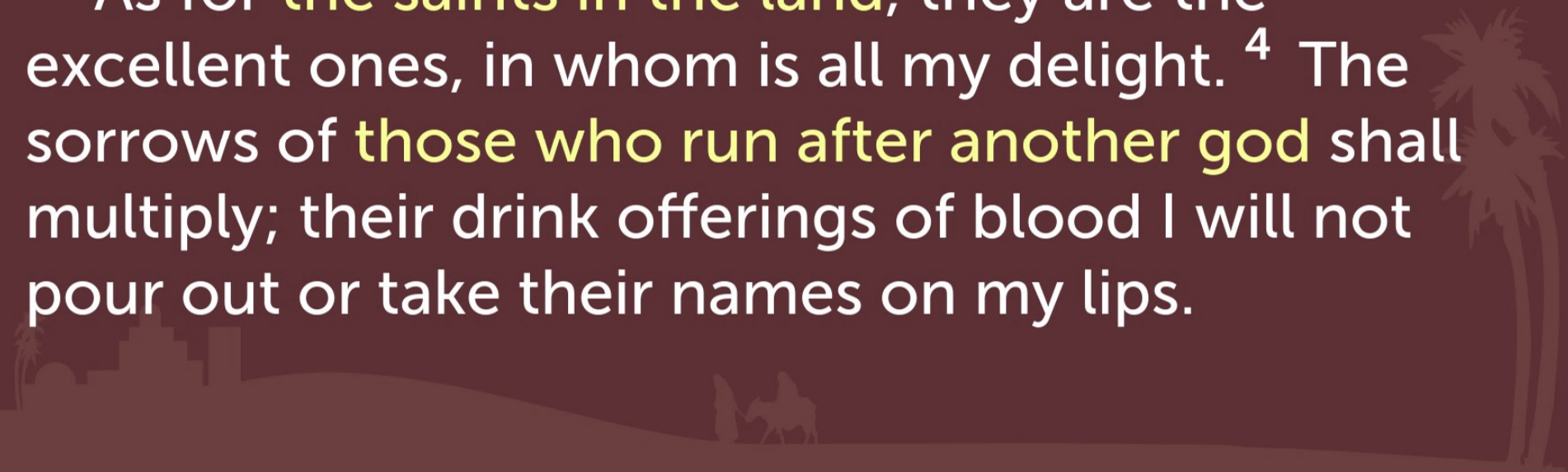
- ¹ **Preserve** me, O God, for in you I take refuge.
