Dear AWCi Family and Partners,

Reflecting on 2023, it's clear that the year brought challenges and moments of great joy. This report represents a brief snapshot of our church's life and growth, showcasing the spiritual, physical, and financial aspects of our journey.

SPIRITUAL UPDATE

- AWCI experienced profound moments of transformation.
- We celebrated 121 salvations or rededications, with 11 men, 30 women, and 15 children becoming members.
- We witnessed 21 baptisms and 11 individuals receiving the Holy Spirit.
- Notable miracles included healing from cancer and other afflictions.

SACRED SEASON

January, July, and August were dedicated to prayer, fasting, and revival—creating sacred moments of reflection and spiritual rejuvenation in our community.

MISSION TRIP & OUTREACH

- Mission Trip:** While we did not embark on international missions this year, our ministry extended its support to Nursing Homes and Christ Central Ministry.
- Outreach & Benevolence Financial Support:** Provided \$5,000.00
- Health Fair & Meal Program:** Served hot meals to 500 families; 25-50 individuals received prostate and breast cancer screenings.
- Community Outreach: Reached over 1000 individuals with support services. \$8,710.00
 - Blood Donation Drives:** Coordinated community blood donations, COVID and flu vaccinations.
 - Free Clothing Distribution:** Provided essential clothing items to those in need.

- Food Baskets:** During Thanksgiving and Christmas, we distributed food baskets, including turkeys and gift cards, to over 25 families throughout the year.
- Fall Festival:** Food, carnival rides, petting zoo, and games:



INTEREST GROUPS & TRAINING

- Conducted Christian Education and Discipleship virtual classes through RightNow Media
- Implemented leadership training courses and in-service training for church leaders and members.
- Launched New Believers class and "Connect" classes for new members integration.
- We offered several classes and training: Self Defense, Healthy Cooking, Eating, & Crafting on a Budget.
- Organized quarterly classes for those aspiring to become facilitators.
- Expanded discipleship program with interest classes covering:

 - Repair Bathroom Damage: **\$3,100.00**
