



LCA Financial Agreement 2026-2027 School Year

Tuition may be paid in full at the beginning of the school year (3% discount) or divided into monthly payments over 9 or 11 months. Tuition is not charged in February. Instead, returning families will be charged the reenrollment fee for the next school year during February. **Prepaid tuition and fees are non-refundable.***

Additional Services

EXTENDED SCHOOL CARE: LCA offers several options for extended school care. For children that are picked up late, there will be a charge of \$10 plus \$1 per minute. On early release Wednesdays, students may stay if they have pre-registered for \$10 per afternoon (2:30-3:35).

SUMMER AT LCA: Adventure Camp and Safari Camp are available for rising Pre-K 4 students through rising 6th grade students during summer break. Athletics camps are also offered. For details, please see the Summer Camp flyer.

Financial Policies

TUITION ASSISTANCE: If a family wishes to request tuition assistance, they must first apply for TEFA and must provide documentation that their application was denied. A scholarship application may be obtained by contacting the school office at office@lakelandchristian.org. Students must be accepted to or enrolled in LCA prior to consideration.

FORCE MAJEURE: Parents agree that LCA shall not be liable for any failure or delay in the performance of its duties or obligations to the extent such failure or delay is caused by a force majeure or an event beyond the school's reasonable control. This includes but is not limited to a fire, flood, act of God, war, government action, act of terrorism, epidemic, pandemic, natural disaster, or other major upheaval which renders performance impractical, illegal, or otherwise inadvisable. In such an event, LCA's duties and obligations shall be suspended until such time as the school, in its sole discretion, determines that it may safely and ably resume performance. LCA shall provide notification of such a suspension in a reasonable time and method. During such a suspension, parents shall make all payments due to the school and there will be no refund of tuition, fees, or other payments previously made. As an alternative to suspending performance, LCA may elect to operate on a virtual-learning basis, may choose to extend its school year, and/or may adopt an alternative schedule to complete its school curriculum.

Discounts

FAMILY DISCOUNT: Families with more than one child enrolled full-time will receive a 5% discount for each additional child.

PREPAYMENT DISCOUNT: Families who choose to pre-pay tuition in full will receive a 3% discount. In order to receive the discount, let the Financial Office know your intentions. The full tuition payment must be made at least two weeks before your payment plan begins (in June or August).

Tuition and Fees

NEW STUDENT APPLICATION FEE: A \$25.00 non-refundable application fee is due at the time of application.

ENROLLMENT / RE-ENROLLMENT FEE: An annual **non-refundable** enrollment fee is due at the time of enrollment. For enrollment fees paid on or before June 1, the cost is \$300. For enrollment fees paid after June 1, the cost is \$350. For returning families, the re-enrollment fee for the upcoming school year will be charged in February (in place of tuition).

FACTS ENROLLMENT FEE: FACTS requires an annual billing fee of \$55 per family (\$25 for pay-in-full or semester plans).

TUITION AND FEES PAYMENT: Three payment plan options are available: (a) Pre-pay all tuition at least two weeks before the payment plan begins and receive a 3% discount; (b) 9 equal monthly payments from August to May (the re-enrollment fee is paid in February); (c) 11 equal monthly payments from June to May (the re-enrollment fee is paid in February). Alternate payment plans must be approved through FACTS. If the prepaid tuition option is selected and all tuition is not paid at least two weeks before your payment plan begins, the 3% discount will be forfeited, and the payment plan will convert to monthly payments. **Prepaid tuition and fees will not be refunded, unless the family moves 30 or more miles out of the area.**

1. Payments must be made by automatic draft from a checking, savings or credit card account through FACTS.
2. FACTS will typically email statements prior to your due date. Drafts typically occur on the 1st or 16th of each month. Advance notice is required for cancellation of bank draft as the method of payment. If there is a disputed charge, please contact our business office. Any adjustment made will show on the next month's school bill.
3. If a payment is returned, a \$30 fee will be charged to the account.
4. A late fee of \$25 will be assessed for any payment that is 2 weeks past due.
5. Parents agree that, if any payment is not made within 30 days of the date due, the student may not be allowed to participate in school services or be accepted or enrolled. The school is under no obligation to provide educational services or activities after payment becomes past due. Payment of all amounts owed is required before the school will provide any certificates, diplomas, records, or transcripts or permit the student to participate in any events, activities, or ceremonies, including graduation.
6. Parents agree that they have read, understand, and agree with the terms above. Parents further agree that they are jointly and severally responsible for the timely payment of all tuition, fees, and other amounts owed.

**Consideration for refunded tuition and fees will only be given if the family moves 30 or more miles out of the area.*
