If you've been around HBC for a while, you would know that at the start of every year, we call the church to an intentional time of prayer and fasting. As we begin 2026, we are setting aside 21 days from January 25 - February 14 to seek God together, to listen, to repent, to intercede, to be formed, and to open our whole lives before Him.

Fasting is, and always has been, an essential practice for the person hungering to grow in God. And we know that growing in our discipleship to Jesus is about so much more than knowing things about Him.

In the spiritual practice of fasting, we allow the whole self to humbly surrender before our holy God. We tune our hearts to the deep longing beneath every other longing: our desire for God Himself.

There are a number of additional prayer and worship gatherings that we encourage you to participate in over the three weeks and we've also curated this PDF resource to help direct and unify our prayers during this season.

This 16-week intentional discipleship course provides a space for meaningful connection, biblical teaching, and Holy Spirit-led transformation. The first 8 weeks explore the nature of faith and the overarching biblical narrative, while the second 8 weeks focus on living out that faith in today's world.

Each session begins with fellowship and worship, followed by a 30-minute teaching, followed by small group discussion in huddles of 3-4, led by a dedicated mentor. Together, you'll reflect, pray, and commit to living out what God is speaking with encouragement and accountability throughout the week.


Finance UPDATE

Overall giving is 1% above budget for the financial year. Giving towards the new building project continues from the all-in campaign, having raised \$31k so far this financial year, with interest on saved building funds contributing an additional \$12k year to date.

Our overall expenses excluding building project costs are 2% below budget YTD. This is very good as we prepare to borrow money for the building project as we are keeping to projected income and planned costs.



Cultivating lasting peace in the workplace

with Dr Jonathan Andrews

'If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.'

(Romans 12:18)

Working and relating with other people is often the hardest thing that we do.

Think of the person at work that gets on your nerves. Sometimes they use their speakerphone as if no one else is in the room. Other times, they seem to undermine every suggestion you make in a meeting.

How do you deal with that person?

Being an example of godly character in the workplace is easy when people get along and everything is going well. But that's not the consistent reality in most workplaces.

Come along to Reframe Peace, hear from Dr Jonathan Andrews (author, lecturer & clinical psychologist) and learn how to share the light of Christ and cultivate God's peace in the workplace, wherever you work.



Dr Jonathan Andrews is a Clinical Psychologist with over 20 years of experience in private practice. He is an Adjunct Professor at the University of Queensland. Jonathan is the author of *'The Reconnected Heart: How Relationships Help Us Heal'*. He works for Heart In Mind, a practice where staff are committed to collaborating with their clients to see them recover and even flourish.
