





There are openings for ministry to refugees through relief and development, and difficult political and living conditions lead to considerable openness. The New Testament, JESUS film, and a number of audio resources are available in Hassaniya Arabic. Pray for those who are, and could be, serving among them. Pray for the Saharawi people to meet Jesus!
