Silent Meditation

In my view it is important that we do not read Psalm 145 simply as an exhortation to praise God or even an exhortation supported by wonderful grounds. For the exhortations of Scripture are always rooted in the grace of God and ultimately in Christ. The New Testament indicates that Jesus Christ is our song leader and that all our praise is offered only in and through him (e.g., Heb. 13:15). In Christ we may respond, by his Spirit, with a relaxed gladness, knowing that this praise does not finally rest on our initiative. Without this Christological orientation, the exhortation to give a praise that is unreserved, unbroken, and unending will be a burden none of us can bear. ~ Christopher Ash



- ²¹ My mouth will speak the praise of the LORD, and let all flesh bless his holy name forever and ever.


