The idea came from a close friend who shared how powerful it was when families would come together, sit around tables, and have meaningful TableTalk conversations. And I thought... why don't we bring that into our Kids Church families?

Introducing: TableTalk

TableTalk is designed for your family to do once a week—coming together around a table, slowing down, and connecting with God and each other. Each TableTalk will include:

- A Bible verse
- Family-friendly discussion questions
- A challenge for the week
- A way to help you build faith at home—one conversation at a time

My heart is to help families grow stronger, not just at church, but at home.

Super Sword Heroes Bible Memory Challenge

TableTalk connects directly to our Super Sword Heroes Bible Memory Challenge, where kids will be encouraged to memorize Scripture and grow strong in the Word of God.

We'll be focusing on the Armor of God, especially the Sword of the Spirit:

"Take up the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God." — Ephesians 6:17

This is what this year is all about—teaching our kids to know Scripture, speak Scripture, and stand on truth.

Here's how it will work:

- Kids will complete Scripture challenges throughout the year.
- Each completed challenge earns a ribbon.
- Each Power Verse completed earns another ribbon.
- Kids can earn up to 11 ribbons.
- If they complete all the challenges, they will earn a medal and a chance to go to lunch with Pastor Shannon and the team.

And I'm going to be doing this right alongside them, because I believe it's important that we are all memorizing Scripture together.

New for 2026: The Bible Bank

We're also launching a Bible Bank that will be located in the check-in room. While you're checking your child in, they can run over to the Bible Bank to:

- Deposit money
- Say their Scripture to the Bible Bank volunteer

It will be a fun and simple way to encourage kids and keep them moving forward.

Children's Ministry


The Super Sword Hero Bible Memory Adventure is a year-long discipleship journey designed to help our 1st-6th grade kids (and their families!) grow strong in God's Word.

Each month focuses on a themed scripture that teaches truth, character, and spiritual strength. Our goal is to equip every child to stand firm in their faith (Ephesians 6:13–15) by learning to use the Sword of the Spirit — God's Word — in everyday life.

Our desire is that every child learns how powerful God's Word truly is — that it's not just words on a page, but living truth that gives them strength, courage, and peace.

We want this program to be more than memory work — we want it to be heart work.





How It Works

Monthly Focus Verse:

- Each month, kids will receive a new Bible verse card tied to that month's theme (Faith, Truth, Prayer, Love, etc.).
- The verse will be discussed in class and at home using Table Talk Family Cards.

Bible Bucks Rewards:

- Kids earn \$ 10.00 Bible Bucks each time they recite their verse.
- Parents are encouraged to memorize the verse too! When a parent recites it, their child earns \$ 10.00 bonus Bible Bucks.

Progress Tracking:

- Each child will have a Super Sword Hero Tracker a fun map showing their achievements.
- A large Bibleland Map that shows our overall memory journey and the verses we've learned together.

As kids memorize God's Word, we want to celebrate their hard work and faithfulness!

- Monthly Passages:
- Each month, kids will have a passage to memorize.
- For each passage they memorize, they will:
 - o Receive a Super Sword Hero ribbon
 - Farn \$30.00 Bible Bucks
- End-of-Year Medal:
- At the end of the program, any child who has completed all of the Bible verses and passages (and we have a record of it on their tracker) will receive a special Super Sword Hero Medal during our celebration.
- Celebration Party:
- We will host a Super Sword Hero Celebration where kids will be awarded their medals and recognized for all the ribbons they've earned throughout the year.

Our heart is that every ribbon, Bible Buck, and medal reminds them that hiding God's Word in their heart is worth celebrating.



Superhero Bible Land Memory Challenge

1) Bible Land Power Verses (Weekly)

Kids will memorize 12 Bible Land Power Verses throughout the year.

For each Power Verse they complete:

- **V** 50 Bible Bucks
- X Aribbon (one ribbon per verse/week)
- 2) Medal Award (When all 12 are complete)

If a child completes all 12 Bible Land Power Verses (and we have it recorded), they will receive:

- X A Superhero Bible Land Medal
- 3) Grand Prize Experience (When all challenges are complete)

If a child completes ALL parts of the Superhero Bible Land Challenge (including all 12 Power Verses) and we have record of it, then Pastor Shannon and the Kids Church team will celebrate them by:

- Taking them out to lunch at a nice place
- # Taking them to Target to pick out a new toy

This is our way of celebrating their hard work, dedication, and love for God's Word!

FEBRUARY CHALLENGE

13 If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. 2 If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. 3 If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, b but do not have love, I gain nothing.

⁴ Love is patient, love is kind. MARCH CHALLENGE

The Armor of God

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. 13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. 14 Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, 15 and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. 16 In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. 17 Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

The Beginning

¹¹Then God said, "Let the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds." And it was so. ¹²The land produced vegetation: plants bearing seed according to their kinds and trees bearing fruit with seed in it according to their kinds. And God saw that it was good. ¹³And there was evening, and there was morning—the third day.

¹⁴And God said, "Let there be lights in the vault of the sky to separate the day from the night, and let them serve as signs to mark sacred times, and days and years, ¹⁵ and let them be lights in the vault of the sky to give light on the earth." And it was so. ¹⁶ God made two great lights—the greater light to govern the day and the lesser light to govern the night. 

The Old Testement





⁴The Lord spoke to you face to face out of the fire on the mountain. ⁵ (At that time I stood between the Lord and you to declare to you the word of the Lord, because you were afraid of the fire and did not go up the mountain.) And he said:

6 "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

7 "You shall have no other gods before a me.

8 "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. 9 You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, 10 but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your ox, your donkey or any of your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns, so that your male and female servants may rest, as you do. 15 Remember that you were slaves in Egypt and that the Lord your God brought you out of there with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm. Therefore the Lord your God has commanded you to observe the Sabbath day.

¹⁶ "Honor your father and your mother, as the Lord your God has commanded you, so that you may live long and that it may go well with you in the land the Lord your God is giving you.

19 "You shall not steal.

20 "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

²¹ "You shall not covet your neighbor's wife. You shall not set your desire on your neighbor's house or land, his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."
