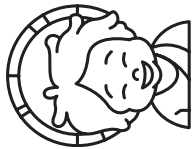
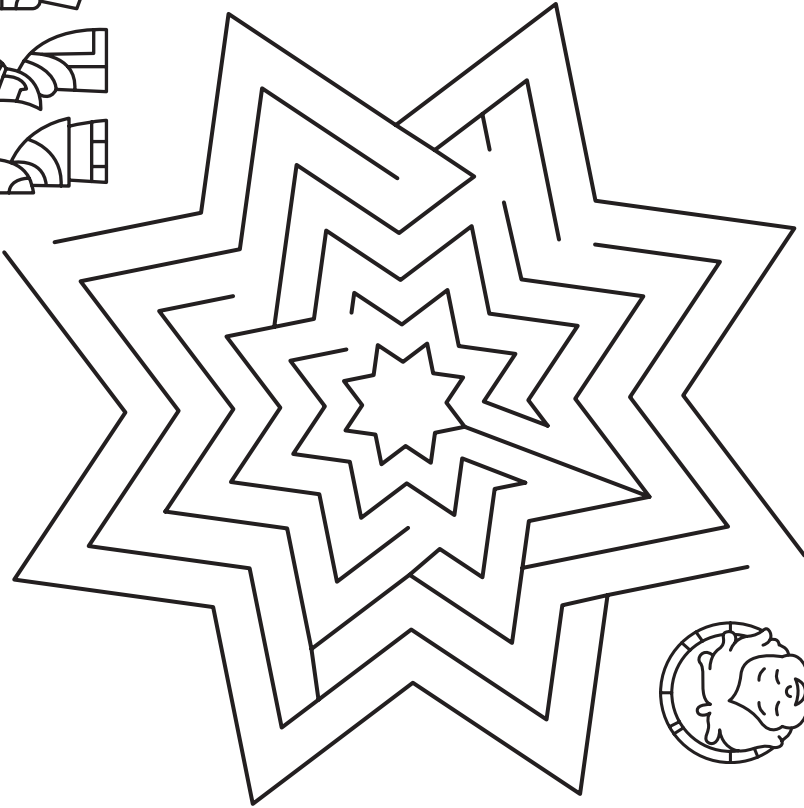
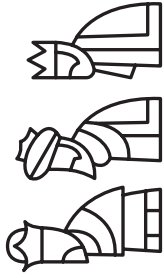


SOLVE THE MAZE

Help the magi find their way to Jesus!

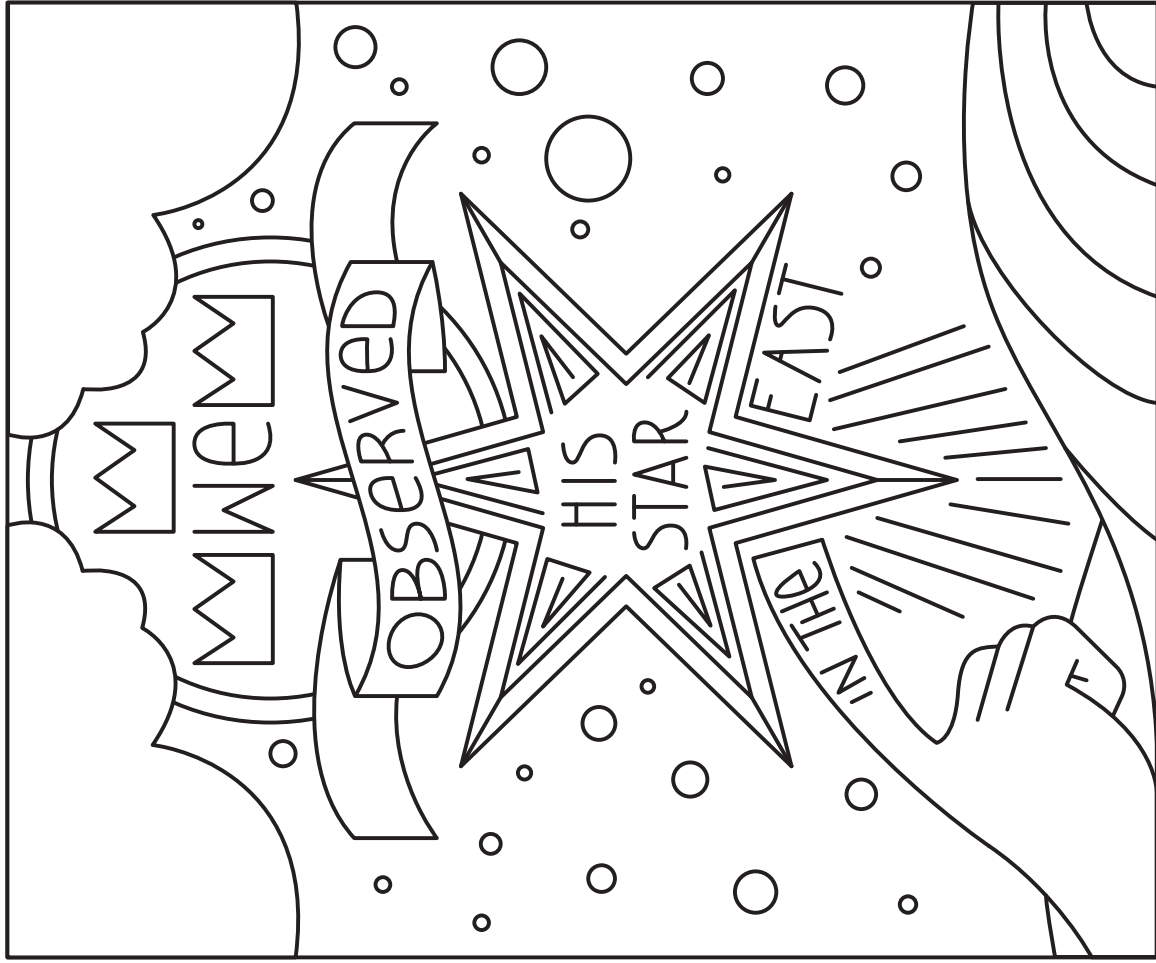


WORDS TO CARRY
