Note from *Pastor Bill*

GOD IS ON THE MOVE “Making Room for What God Is Doing”

As we enter Holy Week we look toward the cross and the empty tomb which points to the greatest truth in all of history: “He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.” (Romans 4:25). Easter is the declaration that Jesus is alive, that sin is forgiven, and that new life is available to all who believe. That same resurrection power is still at work today with Silver Creek.

We are experiencing that resurrection power. Lives are being changed and this church family is growing both in number and in Christ. What we are experiencing is the Holy Spirit at work in us. But with every movement of God comes a responsibility.

Throughout Scripture, when God moves, His people are called to respond in faith and obedience. In Isaiah 54:2, the Lord says: “Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes.” In other words—make room for what I am about to do. I am reminded of the familiar account surrounding Jesus’ birth, when Luke tells us that Mary and Joseph arrived in Bethlehem, only to hear that there was no room for them in the inn (Luke 2:7).

Let us never fail to make room at Silver Creek Methodist!

The resurrected Christ continues to draw people to Himself. And as He draws them, He entrusts them to His Church. This is our calling: to make room—not just in our seats, but in our hearts. As our church family grows, it is our prayer that no one would ever experience what Mary and Joseph did—that no one would feel there is “no room” here.

Instead, every person who walks through our doors would know:

They are welcomed with the love of Christ

They are connected to the body of Christ

They are disciplined to follow Christ

Because making room is not ultimately about space—**it is about stewardship of souls.**

This Holy Week, as we reflect on the cross and celebrate the empty tomb, may we also prepare our hearts and our church for what God is continuing to do. Let us be a people who are ready. And let us be a people who are committed to making room for what God is doing.

He is risen!

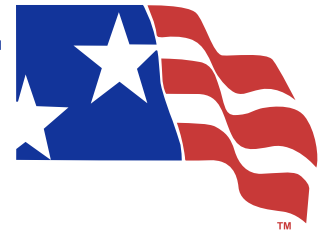

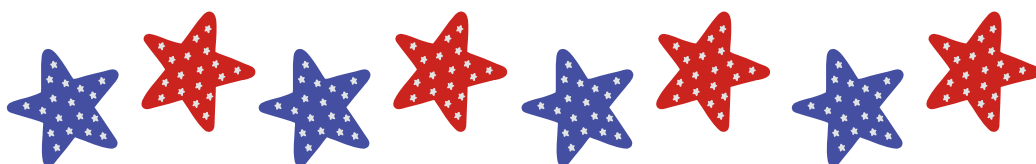
Her heart is to see churches and communities united in prayer, faithful discipleship, and Christ-centered service.
