We met in 1985 at that prestigious center of learning, TCJC, and were married on May 31, 1987—beginning a partnership that has flourished over the decades.





Why do we observe  
Ash Wednesday?



Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a season of repentance, humility, and renewed dependence on God as we prepare our hearts for Easter. On this day, Christians gather to worship, pray, and receive ashes as a visible reminder of our mortality—"you are dust, and to dust you shall return" (Genesis 3:19)—and of God's gracious call to turn back to Him with repentant hearts (Joel 2:12–13). The ashes are about honest self-examination and trust in God's mercy, grounding us again in the Gospel. We practice Ash Wednesday together because repentance and renewal are not meant to be solitary acts; Scripture calls God's people to assemble for worship and repentance, declaring, "Blow the trumpet in Zion; consecrate a fast; call a solemn assembly; gather the people" (Joel 2:15–16), reminding us that we return to the Lord not only as individuals, but as a gathered community seeking His restoring grace.
