

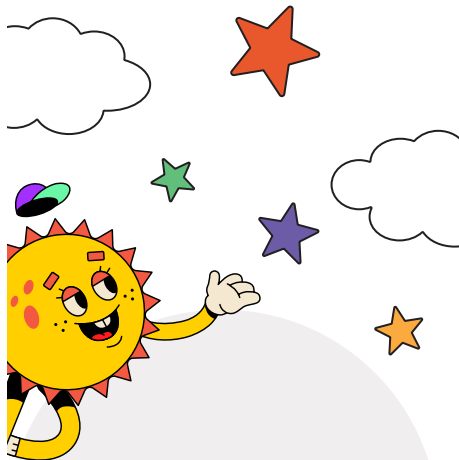
# You can do what Jesus says.

## Bible Story

## ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



### Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I see someone who can do what Jesus says. You! [Child's name] can do what Jesus says!"



### Drive Time

While on the go, look for people caring for one another. Do you see a grownup caring for a baby or child? How about a friend listening to another friend talk? All of these are ways we can do what Jesus says and care for one another.



### Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, please help [child's name] and me do what Jesus says and love like Him."



### Bath Time

Add a toy friend to bath time. Encourage your child to care for their friend by giving them a bath. Talk about how Jesus told a story about a man who cared for someone who was hurt. Jesus wants us to care for one another. When we care for one another, we are doing what Jesus says!



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
