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INTRODUCTION: PREPARE FOR THE WONDER



“CONSECRATE YOURSELVES, BECAUSE THE LORD WILL DO
WONDERS AMONG YOU TOMORROW.”

—JOSHUA 3:5

Before God parted the Jordan River and led His people into the Promised Land, He gave them a simple but powerful instruction: Consecrate yourselves. It was a call to prepare – not by doing more, but by setting themselves apart in faith and obedience.

That's what Saturate 2025 is all about. Not just an event, but a movement of people who are hungry for more of God. A community that believes He still works wonders today—and is willing to prepare their hearts for what's to come. Consecration is the pathway to overflow.

This 30-day devotional journey will guide you through five key themes:

- » Week 1: Surrender – Let go of what's holding you back
- » Week 2: Prayer – Seek God's face with renewed passion
- » Week 3: Holiness – Be set apart for His purpose
- » Week 4: Obedience – Say yes to whatever He says
- » Week 5: Overflow – Live from the abundance of His Spirit

Each weekday, you'll read a short devotion, reflect on a key passage of Scripture, pray a guided prayer, and consider how to apply what you've read. These moments are where we can hear God speak to us. They are not just for inspiration, but they are invitations to transformation.

Jesus said, *"My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me."* — John 10:27

One of the greatest privileges of being a child of God for every person who has been saved, is that we get to hear His voice. Let this devotional journey be an opportunity to hear from God in a fresh, real, and powerful way.

LET FASTING BE A PART OF YOUR PREPARATION

Throughout Scripture, fasting has been a powerful way to consecrate oneself before the Lord. When we fast, we intentionally let go of lesser things—food, distractions, comforts—so we can cling more tightly to Jesus.

During this 30-day journey, we invite you to choose a fast that helps you press in more deeply to God's presence. Whether it's a food fast, a social media break, or eliminating something else that competes for your attention, fasting creates spiritual space for God's voice to grow louder in your life.

You can fast one day a week, one meal a day, or for specific periods during this journey. The goal isn't performance—it's presence. Let fasting be an act of surrender and longing that draws you closer to the Lord.

YOUR POSTURE FOR THE NEXT 30 DAYS

- **Come hungry**—for God more than anything else
- **Come open**—ready to be challenged, changed, and used
- **Come expectant**—because the Lord will do wonders among us

Let these daily devotions be your altar. Let your prayers be your preparation. Let your fast be your offering. And may what God begins in you during these 30 days flow far beyond you—for His glory and the good of others.

Because when you consecrate yourself to the Lord, you're not just preparing for a moment—you're preparing for wonders.

Let's walk into Saturate with hearts ready for revival... and lives fully surrendered.

WEEK 1: SURRENDER



DAY 1 – LETTING GO TO MOVE FORWARD

MONDAY, August 25

SCRIPTURE:

“FORGET THE FORMER THINGS; DO NOT DWELL ON THE PAST. SEE, I AM DOING A NEW THING!” — ISAIAH 43:18–19

DEVOTION:

The Israelites had to cross the Jordan before they could see the Promised Land. But to move forward, they had to leave behind their fear, failure, and even familiarity. Surrender is the sacred act of letting go. What do you need to release today—shame, control, comfort, pride?

God isn't asking you to fix everything—He's asking you to open your hands and trust Him with the outcome.

PRAYER:

Lord, help me let go of what's behind me so I can walk with You into what's ahead.

CHALLENGE:

Write down what you're holding onto that needs to be released. Pray over it. Tear it up as a symbol of surrender.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 2 – TRUSTING GOD COMPLETELY

TUESDAY, August 26

SCRIPTURE:

“TRUST IN THE LORD WITH ALL YOUR HEART AND LEAN NOT ON YOUR OWN UNDERSTANDING.” — PROVERBS 3:5

DEVOTION:

Partial surrender is no surrender at all. God doesn't ask for a piece of your heart; He asks for it all. Trust is rooted in knowing God's character—that He is good, faithful, and with you.

Surrender means saying, “Even when I don't understand, I'll obey.” The beauty of full surrender is that it frees you from the weight of self-reliance.

PRAYER:

God, I surrender my understanding to You. I trust Your plans more than my own.

CHALLENGE:

Each time you feel worry rise today, whisper: “I trust You, Jesus.”

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 3 – LETTING GO OF THE PAST

WEDNESDAY, August 27

SCRIPTURE:

“ANYONE WHO BELONGS TO CHRIST HAS BECOME A NEW PERSON. THE OLD LIFE IS GONE; A NEW LIFE HAS BEGUN!” — 2 CORINTHIANS 5:17

DEVOTION:

The past has power—until you surrender it. Regret, failure, even past success can keep us stuck. But God doesn't define you by what's behind you. Through Jesus, you are made new.

Surrender your past not just to forget it, but to let God redeem it. Your testimony isn't what you've done—it's what God has done with your surrender.

PRAYER:

Father, I give You my past. Use it for Your glory and remind me that I am made new in You.

CHALLENGE:

Share a story of God's faithfulness from your past with someone today.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 4 – SURRENDERING YOUR PLANS

THURSDAY, August 28

SCRIPTURE:

“MANY ARE THE PLANS IN A PERSON’S HEART, BUT IT IS THE LORD’S PURPOSE THAT PREVAILS.” — PROVERBS 19:21

DEVOTION:

We often bring God our plans and ask Him to bless them. But true surrender flips that script—we ask God for His plans and align ourselves with them. Surrendering your plans means choosing purpose over preference.

It doesn't mean your dreams don't matter—it means you trust God to shape them.

PRAYER:

God, I surrender my plans and dreams. Help me desire Your purpose more than my own agenda.

CHALLENGE:

Pause today before making any big decisions and pray, “God, what do You want?”

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 5 – SURRENDERING CONTROL

FRIDAY, August 29

SCRIPTURE:

“BE STILL, AND KNOW THAT I AM GOD.” — PSALM 46:10

DEVOTION:

Control is often rooted in fear. We want to manage outcomes, manipulate results, and minimize risk. But God invites us to be still. Stillness is a form of surrender. It says, “I’m not in control, but I know who is.”

True spiritual power is found not in grasping, but in giving up.

PRAYER:

Jesus, I let go of control. I surrender to Your leadership in every area of my life.

CHALLENGE:

Choose one thing you’ve been trying to control—give it to God in prayer and take one practical step back from it.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today’s devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

WEEKEND BONUS - SATURATE RECALL DEVO

"Letting Go to Move Forward"

Devotional Life with God is a journey of seasons. Just as nature transitions from winter to spring, summer to fall, our spiritual lives move through different phases. God is constantly calling us higher, deeper, and further in our relationship with Him. But sometimes, we find ourselves stuck, unable to advance despite hearing His call. What's holding us back? Often, it's the excess baggage we're carrying. Like a hiker attempting to climb a mountain with an overloaded backpack, we struggle to ascend because we're weighed down by things that don't belong in our next season. Jesus identified this problem in the parable of the sower. Some seed falls among thorns, representing hearts so full of worldly concerns that God's word gets choked out. We can be so preoccupied with worries, wealth, and wants that there's simply no room for God's presence to flourish. The journey upward requires an honest assessment: What needs to stay, and what needs to go? This isn't about arbitrary sacrifice but strategic elimination. God isn't calling us to less—He's calling us to more. But to receive the more, we must sometimes release what's in our hands.



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BIBLE VERSE

"Still others, like seed sown among thorns, hear the word; but the worries of this life, the deceitfulness of wealth and the desires for other things come in and choke the word, making it unfruitful." - Mark 4:18-19

REFLECTION QUESTION

What specific concerns, possessions, or desires might be taking up space in your heart that God wants to fill with His presence instead?

"TO ELEVATE, YOU MAY HAVE TO ELIMINATE. THERE'S SOME STUFF THAT MIGHT HAVE TO GO. IF GOD'S GOING TO SATURATE OUR HEARTS, IF WE'RE GOING TO LET HIM BE WHAT FILLS OUR SOUL, WHAT WE'RE GOING TO REALIZE IS THAT HE IS MORE THAN ENOUGH."

PRAYER

Lord, help me recognize what's weighing me down and preventing me from moving forward with You. Give me the courage to open my hands and release what doesn't belong in this new season. I want to make room for more of You. Amen.

WEEK 2: PRAYER

“CONSECRATE YOURSELVES, BECAUSE THE LORD WILL DO
WONDERS AMONG YOU TOMORROW.” — JOSHUA 3:5

When God called His people to consecrate themselves, prayer was at the center. Prayer is not a religious ritual—it's a relationship. It's how we draw near to God, hear His voice, and align our hearts with His will. If we want to experience God's wonders tomorrow, we must seek His presence today.



DAY 8 – RESTING IN GOD’S PRESENCE

MONDAY, September 1

SCRIPTURE:

“COME TO ME, ALL YOU WHO ARE WEARY AND BURDENED, AND I WILL GIVE YOU REST.” — MATTHEW 11:28

DEVOTION:

Prayer is more than words—it’s presence. It’s choosing to sit with God, not just speak to Him. In a world addicted to noise, rest becomes a radical act of faith. It says, “God, I trust You enough to slow down.”

Let God speak into the silence. Rest in Him. He’s not waiting for you to perform—He’s waiting for you to come.

PRAYER:

God, today I don’t come with a list—I come to sit with You. Let my soul rest in Your presence.

CHALLENGE:

Spend 10 minutes in silence with God. No music. No words. Just stillness.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today’s devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 9 – HONEST PRAYERS FROM A HEAVY HEART

TUESDAY, September 2

SCRIPTURE:

“POUR OUT YOUR HEARTS BEFORE HIM; GOD IS OUR REFUGE.” — PSALM 62:8

DEVOTION:

God isn't interested in polished prayers. He wants honest ones. When your heart is heavy, don't pretend—pour it out. Even Jesus prayed with tears and anguish. He understands.

Bring Him the real stuff: the grief, confusion, anger, joy, and hope. He's not overwhelmed by your emotions—He invites them.

PRAYER:

Lord, I bring You the real me. Help me pray with honesty and trust that You hear me.

CHALLENGE:

Journal a raw, unfiltered prayer today. Say what you're really feeling.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 10 – THE POWER OF INTERCESSION

SPECIAL REMINDER: PRAYER NIGHT

TCAL CAMPUS: 6:30-7:30

WEDNESDAY, September 3

SCRIPTURE:

“I URGE THAT PETITIONS, PRAYERS, INTERCESSIONS, AND THANKSGIVINGS BE MADE FOR EVERYONE.” — 1 TIMOTHY 2:1

DEVOTION:

To intercede is to stand in the gap. It's prayer that goes beyond yourself—praying for friends, family, your church, your city. Intercession is love on its knees. You may never know the impact of your prayers, but heaven does. Who is God calling you to pray for today?

PRAYER:

Jesus, give me a heart like Yours—one that pleads for others and doesn't grow tired.

CHALLENGE:

Make a list of five people to intercede for this week. Pray over each by name today.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 11 – PRAYING GOD’S WORD

THURSDAY, September 4

SCRIPTURE:

“YOUR WORD IS A LAMP FOR MY FEET, A LIGHT ON MY PATH.” — PSALM 119:105

DEVOTION:

Want to deepen your prayer life? Pray the Word. Scripture isn't just for study—it's a weapon, a comfort, and a guide. When you don't know what to say, let God's Word shape your prayers.

Speak it out loud. Personalize it. Let it stir your faith.

PRAYER:

God, let Your Word fill my prayers. Teach me to speak Your promises over my life and others.

CHALLENGE:

Choose one verse and pray it over yourself or someone else today.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 12 – PERSISTENT PRAYER

FRIDAY, September 5

SCRIPTURE:

“PRAY WITHOUT CEASING.” — 1 THESSALONIANS 5:17

DEVOTION:

Persistence in prayer isn't about nagging God—it's about trusting Him enough to keep coming. When Jesus taught on prayer, He told stories of people who didn't give up. That's the kind of faith that moves mountains.

Even when you don't see it yet—keep praying. You never know what God is preparing behind the scenes.

PRAYER:

Father, strengthen my faith to pray persistently, not passively. Help me trust even in silence.

CHALLENGE:

Revisit a prayer you've stopped praying. Pick it back up today and ask again in faith.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

WEEKEND BONUS - SATURATE RECALL DEVO

"Resting in God's Presence"

Devotional Rest is not just a physical necessity but a spiritual discipline. God wants us to rest with Him before we work with Him. In our rest, we find clarity, purpose, and calling. When we are undersaturated, we become irritable and ineffective. This week, let's prioritize rest in God's presence, trusting that He will provide the strength and guidance we need for our daily tasks.



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BIBLE VERSE

And he said to them, 'Come away by yourselves to a desolate place and rest a while.' For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat. - Mark 6:31

REFLECTION QUESTION

How can you prioritize rest in God's presence to find clarity and purpose in your life?

GOD WANTED YOU TO REST WITH HIM BEFORE HE COULD
EVER TEACH YOU TO WORK WITH HIM.

PRAYER

Father, teach me to rest in Your presence. Help me to prioritize time with You, knowing that it will bring clarity and purpose to my life. Saturate me with Your peace and strength. Amen.



WEEK 3: HOLINESS

**“CONSECRATE YOURSELVES, BECAUSE THE LORD WILL DO
WONDERS AMONG YOU TOMORROW.” — JOSHUA 3:5**

To consecrate means to be set apart for God's purposes. Holiness isn't about being perfect—it's about being surrendered, available, and distinct from the world. God calls His people to live holy lives not out of fear, but in response to His grace. Holiness is a reflection of who God is—and an invitation for His presence to dwell in us.



DAY 15 – TRANSFORMED, NOT CONFORMED

MONDAY, September 8

SCRIPTURE:

“DO NOT CONFORM TO THE PATTERN OF THIS WORLD, BUT BE TRANSFORMED BY THE RENEWING OF YOUR MIND.” — ROMANS 12:2

DEVOTION:

Holiness starts with the way we think. The world has a pattern—self, pride, compromise. But God calls us to a different way. We don't drift toward holiness; we choose it daily by renewing our minds in truth.

The more time you spend with God, the more you'll begin to see and desire what He sees and desires. That's transformation.

PRAYER:

God, renew my mind today. Help me resist the pull of the world and choose to be set apart for You.

CHALLENGE:

Identify one worldly mindset you've been conforming to. Replace it with a scripture-based truth today.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 16 – LIVING A LIFE OF DEPENDENCY

TUESDAY, September 9

SCRIPTURE:

“REMAIN IN ME, AS I ALSO REMAIN IN YOU. NO BRANCH CAN BEAR FRUIT BY ITSELF.” — JOHN 15:4

DEVOTION:

Holiness is not about trying harder—it's about abiding deeper. We don't produce holiness in our own strength. It flows from our connection with Jesus. The more we depend on Him, the more His character shapes ours.

You were never meant to bear fruit alone. Stay close to the Vine.

PRAYER:

Jesus, I can't live a holy life without You. Teach me to depend on You in every moment.

CHALLENGE:

Every time you face a temptation today, pause and whisper, “Jesus, I need You.”

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 17 – PURITY IN A POLLUTED WORLD

WEDNESDAY, September 10

SCRIPTURE:

“BLESSED ARE THE PURE IN HEART, FOR THEY WILL SEE GOD.” — MATTHEW 5:8

DEVOTION:

Purity isn't just about avoiding sin—it's about focusing your heart entirely on God. In a world flooded with distractions and distortions, pursuing purity takes intentionality.

The reward? Clarity. Connection. Seeing God more clearly. A pure heart creates space for God's presence.

PRAYER:

Create in me a pure heart, O God. Help me fix my eyes on You and reject what pollutes my soul.

CHALLENGE:

Fast from one form of digital or worldly noise for the next 24 hours. Use that time to pursue God's voice instead.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 18 – THE BATTLE FOR HOLINESS

THURSDAY, September 11

SCRIPTURE:

“SO I SAY, WALK BY THE SPIRIT, AND YOU WILL NOT GRATIFY THE DESIRES OF THE FLESH.” — GALATIANS 5:16

DEVOTION:

Holiness is a fight. Every day, we battle the flesh—the part of us that resists God's way. But the good news is this: you don't fight alone. The Spirit of God lives in you and gives you power to overcome.

Victory doesn't come by trying to be better. It comes by choosing to walk with the Spirit.

PRAYER:

Holy Spirit, empower me to walk in step with You. Strengthen me to say yes to You and no to sin.

CHALLENGE:

Ask the Spirit to reveal one area where compromise has crept in. Confess it and take one step toward holiness today.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 19 – A LIFE THAT REFLECTS HIM

FRIDAY, September 12

SCRIPTURE:

“BUT JUST AS HE WHO CALLED YOU IS HOLY, SO BE HOLY IN ALL YOU DO.” —
1 PETER 1:15

DEVOTION:

God's call to holiness isn't about legalism—it's about likeness. When people see your life, do they see Jesus? Holiness isn't about perfection, but direction. It's about choosing to reflect God's nature in your words, actions, and relationships.

You are a walking billboard for God's grace. Let your life point people to Him.

PRAYER:

Father, make my life a reflection of Yours. Let my holiness draw others to Your goodness.

CHALLENGE:

Find one way today to reflect God's character to someone—through kindness, forgiveness, or integrity.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

WEEKEND BONUS - SATURATE RECALL DEVO

"Transformed, Not Conformed"

Devotional In a world constantly trying to shape us into its image, God calls us to something radically different. He doesn't just want to protect us from negative influences—He wants to transform us into powerful agents of His kingdom. Think about the difference between a basketball sitting on a shelf versus one in the hands of a skilled player. On the shelf, it's just an object. But in the right hands, it becomes part of something extraordinary. Similarly, our lives gain their greatest value and purpose when surrendered to God's skilled hands. We often try to maintain control of our lives, making our own plans and pursuing our own agendas. But the truth is, we vastly underestimate what God can do with a fully surrendered life. When we resist being conformed to this world and instead allow God to transform us through the renewing of our minds, we discover His good, pleasing, and perfect will—not just for our benefit, but for His kingdom's advancement.



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BIBLE VERSE

"Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will." - Romans 12:2

REFLECTION QUESTION

In what areas of your life are you still trying to maintain control rather than fully surrendering to God's transforming work?

WE OVERESTIMATE WHAT WE CAN DO WITH OUR LIFE. AND WE VASTLY UNDERESTIMATE WHAT THE KING OF ALL KINGS AND THE LORD OF ALL LORDS CAN DO WITH OUR LIFE, OUR MARRIAGE, OUR BUSINESS, OUR FINANCES, OUR EVERYTHING IN HIS HANDS.

PRAYER

Lord, forgive me for the ways I've tried to maintain control of my life. I recognize that You can do far more with my surrendered life than I could ever accomplish on my own. Transform my mind today and help me resist conforming to the patterns of this world. Amen.

WEEK 4: OBEDIENCE

“CONSECRATE YOURSELVES, BECAUSE THE LORD WILL DO
WONDERS AMONG YOU TOMORROW.” — JOSHUA 3:5

Consecration isn't passive—it leads to action. Holiness without obedience is incomplete. God's blessings and wonders often follow steps of faith and obedience, even when they don't make sense. Obedience is the evidence of a surrendered heart and the posture of a life ready to be used by God.

DAY 22 – OBEDIENCE TO GOD’S CALL

MONDAY, September 15

SCRIPTURE:

“THEN I HEARD THE VOICE OF THE LORD SAYING, ‘WHOM SHALL I SEND? AND WHO WILL GO FOR US?’ AND I SAID, ‘HERE AM I. SEND ME!’” — ISAIAH 6:8

DEVOTION:

God's call often interrupts our comfort. Obedience means saying “yes” to God before you know all the details. Like Isaiah, we must respond to God's voice with willingness and courage.

The world needs more people who say, “Here I am,” even when the mission is hard.

PRAYER:

Lord, make my heart quick to say yes to You. I'm available. I'm willing. I'm Yours.

CHALLENGE:

What's one thing God's been asking you to do that you've delayed? Take one obedient step today.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 23 – OBEDIENCE IN THE SMALL THINGS

TUESDAY, September 16

SCRIPTURE:

“WHOEVER CAN BE TRUSTED WITH VERY LITTLE CAN ALSO BE TRUSTED WITH MUCH.” — LUKE 16:10

DEVOTION:

God often tests our obedience in the small, unseen things before entrusting us with more. The way you respond in the little moments—honesty, integrity, kindness—sets the stage for greater impact.

Obedience isn't always loud. Sometimes it looks like being faithful when no one is watching.

PRAYER:

Jesus, help me to obey You in the little things. Make me trustworthy in every area of life.

CHALLENGE:

Choose faithfulness in one small area today: your words, your time, your attitude, or your follow-through.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

What specific step of faith or obedience do I need to take in response?

DAY 24 – WHEN OBEDIENCE DOESN'T MAKE SENSE

WEDNESDAY, September 17

SCRIPTURE:

“BY FAITH NOAH, WHEN WARNED ABOUT THINGS NOT YET SEEN, IN HOLY FEAR BUILT AN ARK TO SAVE HIS FAMILY.” — HEBREWS 11:7

DEVOTION:

Obedience doesn't always come with clarity or applause. Noah obeyed God in something that seemed crazy—and it saved generations. Sometimes, God's direction may seem illogical to others—but it's an opportunity for trust.

Obedience isn't about understanding—it's about believing God knows best.

PRAYER:

God, even when it doesn't make sense to me or those around me, help me obey You fully.

CHALLENGE:

Think of a time you hesitated because you didn't fully understand. Ask God to give you clarity—or courage to move without it.

REFLECT:

What is the Holy Spirit revealing to me through today's devotion?

DAY 25 – OBEDIENCE THROUGH SUFFERING

THURSDAY, September 18

SCRIPTURE:

DEVOTION:

Even Jesus learned obedience through suffering. Obedience often costs something—comfort, popularity, pride. But when we endure through hardship for the sake of obedience, we grow in maturity and faith.

Devotional God has called each of us to be part of His movement. This requires obedience to His call. Sometimes, we may hesitate or feel inadequate, but God equips those He calls. Remember, you may be the only Jesus someone ever sees. Your obedience can make a lasting impact on someone's life. Reflect on how you can be obedient to God's call in your life and take steps to act on it. The movement doesn't happen if we don't move.

REFLECTION QUESTION

Do you believe you are sent? How can you be obedient to God's call in your life today?

Lord, help me to be obedient to Your call. Equip me and give me the courage to act on it, knowing that You are with me every step of the way. Amen.



WEEK 5: OVERFLOW

“CONSECRATE YOURSELVES, BECAUSE THE LORD WILL DO WONDERS AMONG YOU TOMORROW.” — JOSHUA 3:5

When God fills a life, it doesn't stay contained. The result of surrender, prayer, holiness, and obedience is overflow—His Spirit spilling out into every area of our lives. The world doesn't just need to hear the gospel; it needs to see it lived out in people who walk in joy, purpose, generosity, and power. You were never meant to be a reservoir. You were meant to be a river.
