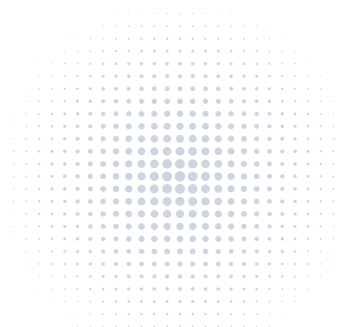
What a joy it is to gather in God's Presence!
