Up to 220 guests

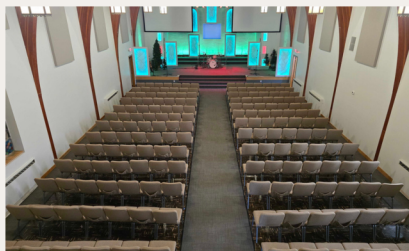
A conveniently located StoneBridge campus with an inviting, industrial-chic atmosphere.

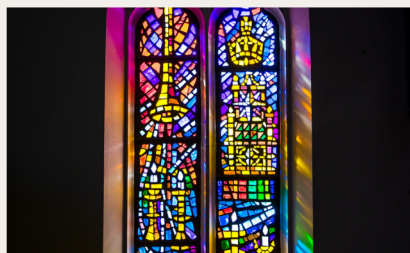

Pre-Marital Counseling

Two 90-minute premarital counseling sessions with a StoneBridge pastor using the Prepare/Enrich curriculum. These sessions provide a meaningful opportunity to deepen connection, build strong relational skills, and thoughtfully prepare for a lifelong partnership.

Officiant

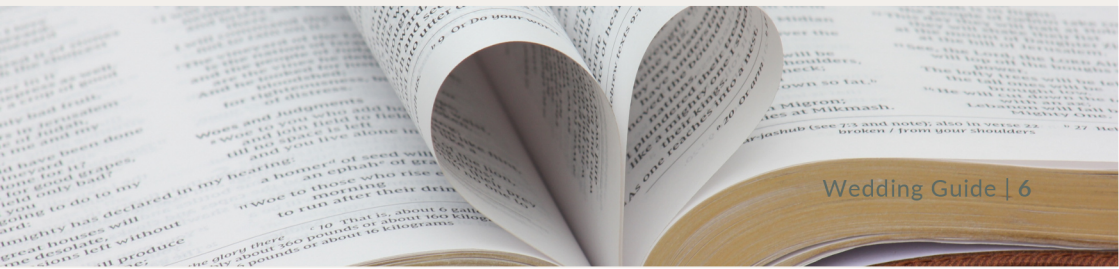
StoneBridge will provide a pastor to serve as your wedding officiant. They will facilitate premarital counseling and get to know the couple and plan the elements of the wedding ceremony.

Coordinator

The wedding coordinator will help with the rehearsal and ceremony. They will meet with the couple twice to ensure that all the details for the wedding day are covered.

Sound Tech

Your sound tech will set up and run equipment the day of the wedding. A sound check will take place with the officiant and anyone else involved in the ceremony at the rehearsal. The sound tech will begin interlude music 30 minutes before the ceremony.

Questions

Q: How far in advance should we book?

StoneBridge will accept booking starting in December of the previous year.

Q: Is pre-marital counseling required?

Yes, all weddings at Stonebridge, or using a StoneBridge officiant require pre-marital counseling.

Q: Can I have my reception at StoneBridge?

Reception space at StoneBridge is incredibly limited. Most weddings will require an off-site reception.

Q: Can I use my own officiant?

Yes, you can submit a request to use your own officiant that must be approved by the StoneBridge pastoral staff.

Q: Can my rehearsal dinner be at StoneBridge?

Absolutely! Review the add-ons list for pricing details.

Q: Can I choose which StoneBridge pastor will be my officiant?

Choose your preferred pastor on the Wedding Inquiry Form. Subject to pastor's availability.

Q: Can I use my own Wedding Coordinator?

A StoneBridge Wedding Coordinator is required to keep communication with StoneBridge staff and calendar smooth. However, we would be thrilled to work with your wedding coordinator!

A Letter From the Elders

Our Belief About Marriage

Congratulations on your upcoming wedding and marriage! At StoneBridge Christian Church, we believe that marriage is a sacred covenant created by God. From the beginning, Scripture teaches that marriage is the lifelong union of one man and one woman, established by God for companionship, mutual support, and the formation of family (**Genesis 2:24**).

Marriage is designed to reflect God's faithful love and commitment. Throughout Scripture, marriage is described as a covenant relationship marked by love, sacrifice, faithfulness, and unity (**Ephesians 5:21-33**). Because of this, we believe marriage is more than a social contract or ceremonial event—it is a spiritual covenant made before God. God's Word teaches that marriage is a sacred uniting by God of a man and a woman, therefore StoneBridge Christian Church and its pastors support marriages and perform weddings only for one man and one woman making vows before God.

We also believe that God's design for marriage includes sexual intimacy reserved for the marriage covenant and a lifelong commitment between husband and wife (**Hebrews 13:4**).

Because we care deeply about the strength and health of marriages, StoneBridge seeks to equip couples with biblical wisdom and practical tools that help build lasting, Christ-centered relationships.

Weddings for StoneBridge Attenders

When a StoneBridge pastor officiates a wedding for individuals who are part of the StoneBridge church community, we view the wedding not simply as a ceremony but as the beginning of a pastoral partnership in preparing for marriage.

Couples seeking to be married by a StoneBridge pastor are asked to participate in the following:

1. Premarital Preparation

Couples will complete premarital counseling or a premarital seminar designed to help them build a strong biblical foundation for marriage.

2. Preparation Timeline

Couples are encouraged to allow adequate time for marriage preparation. Typically we recommend a minimum of six months prior to the wedding. If divorced, at least one year of legal divorce must pass before consideration for remarriage. We believe a new relationship should not be pursued until the potential of a healthy reconciliation has been exhausted and time for personal recovery has passed. (**1 Corinthians 7:10-11**)

3. *Spiritual Alignment*

Because Scripture teaches that followers of Jesus should pursue unity in faith within marriage (**1 Corinthians 7:39-40, 2 Corinthians 6:14-16, 1 John 5:1-5**), pastors officiate weddings where both individuals share a commitment to Christ.

4. *Regular Attendance at StoneBridge*

In order to be in partnership together, it is important that you regularly attend church together so you know who we are and what we stand for.

5. *Biblical Vision for Marriage*

Couples should understand and be willing to pursue God's design for marriage, including faithfulness, lifelong commitment, and sexual purity within the covenant of marriage.

The principle of sexual purity prior to marriage is very clear in scripture (**1 Thessalonians 4:3-8**). Because of this, couples currently living together or who are currently involved in a sexual relationship prior to marriage must be willing to separate and abstain from sexual intimacy until after marriage.

If you have an extenuating circumstance that needs special consideration, please discuss this with the officiating pastor.

Weddings at StoneBridge as a Venue

StoneBridge Christian Church may also make its facilities available to couples who wish to host a wedding ceremony at the church.

In these situations:

- The church is serving primarily as a venue provider.
- Couples may choose their own officiant, subject to church approval and facility policies. Pre-marriage counseling is still a requirement and can be provided by the officiating pastor or through StoneBridge.
- All ceremonies hosted at StoneBridge must be consistent with the church's statement of faith and belief that marriage is the covenant union of one man and one woman.
