

## **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

These questions are designed to help groups discuss this weekend's sermon while building relationships with each other and applying God's Word to our lives.

Week of November 23, 2025

#### **GETTING STARTED**

- Where have you seen God at work in your life throughout this series?
  Have you grown in your relationship with, and understanding of, the
  Holy Spirit?
- Brandon opened with a simple question: Can these bones live? What's a place in your life right now that feels spiritually dry or lifeless?
- What's your reaction to praying "Come, Holy Spirit"? Hopeful?
  Confused? Uncomfortable? Hungry?

#### **DIGGING INTO SCRIPTURE**

Read Ezekiel 37:1-14 out loud.

- 1. What do the bones represent in this vision? Why do you think God shows Ezekiel this scene?
- 2. In verse 3, God asks, "Can these bones live?" and Ezekiel responds, "Sovereign Lord, only You know."
  - What does that response reveal?
  - Where do you need to say the same thing right now?



### **DIGGING INTO SCRIPTURE (CONT.)**

#### Read Joel 2:28-32 out loud.

- What does it say about God's heart that He promises to pour out His Spirit on "all people"?
- Peter quotes this in Acts 2 to describe Pentecost. What's the connection between revival and the Holy Spirit?
- Can you think of a time in which you've experienced revival or spiritual renewal? What was it like?

#### HONEST REFLECTION

- Brandon said that cynicism is one of the biggest barriers to revival or being spiritually ignited again . Where have you become cynical in your faith or in our culture?
- The vision in Ezekiel showed God bringing life through His Word and His Spirit. Which of those do you lean on more? What would it look like to live with both?

# PRAYER FOCUS I Pray slowly together: "Come, Holy Spirit."

- Where do you want the Holy Spirit to breathe life into you again?
- Close your time by praying, "Come, Holy Spirit." Wait quietly, and ask God to stir fresh faith, purpose, and hope.
