DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUPS, FAMILIES, & INDIVIDUAL STUDY

Ice Breaker (if needed):

Share a go-to home remedy you use when you are sick.

- 1. "There must be more..." Share a time when you felt a longing for purpose. Why did/do you feel this way? What is purpose? Why is it a core longing? When did you begin to notice your need for purpose? What is your purpose?
- 2. Purpose is found in our response to God's call.
 - · Read 1 Kings 19:19-21
 - What was Elisha's response to God's call, given through Elijah? Why did Elisha react this way?
 - What was Simon Peter's reaction to Jesus calling him to leave everything and become a fisher of men? (Matthew 4:19-20)
 - How does your "not yet" or "when X happens" undermine the purpose found in responding to God's call?
- 3. Purpose is found when we don't put conditions on God's call.
 - Read Luke 9:61-62
 - · What did burning the plow reveal about Elisha's heart?
 - · Why did Jesus reject the man's conditions in Luke? What is the plow?
 - Ask God to show you where you are content to live in a state of half-heartedness. What are reasons people won't go all-in when God reveals purpose?
 - Are you going to serve, share, teach, engage what God is calling you to or not?
 - Read Acts 2:17. Does age or lack of experience excuse you from rallying to His call? Why or why not?
- 4. Purpose comes from God's presence.
 - Read 2 Kings 3:9-19
 - How did Elisha handle the questions of the kings? Why was Elisha able to speak the Lord's word? What does it mean to abide?
 - · If you were in His presence, there is no way you'd say, "There must be more!" Why?
- 5. Purpose is positional. It is a mindset. It is how you orient your life.
 - · Read Ephesians 2:10
 - How do you know God has something for you to do? Try to build a case why you might be an exception to this verse. If you can't, congratulations!
 - What will you find if you go through the doors God gives you? What if there are more doors?
