

21 DAYS OF PRAYER: DAILY GUIDE

LET US ALL PRAY TOGETHER!

There is so much power in unity and in prayer! Let's all pray together for the same things every day for the next 21 days. God will knit us together and do amazing things in our midst!

- ☐ **Day 1: Praise Him!** Pray James 1:16-17 aloud. Pray prayers of thanksgiving and worship. Reflect on the good God has done in your life and our church family this past season and thank Him for it. Read Colossians 1:16-17. Praise God for what He is doing now and what He's going to do.
- ☐ **Day 2: Repentance.** Pray Psalm 139:23-24 aloud. Wait to see what God brings to mind. Confess any sin He reveals and repent by committing to walk away from it. Read 2 Chronicles 7:12-16. Pray for God to restore and return anything in your life that has been broken or stolen by sin.
- ☐ **Day 3: Protection.** Pray Ephesians 6:10-18 aloud. Pray for God's protection over your life, your family, and your friends. Pray for protection over our church and its ministries.
- ☐ **Day 4: Our Leaders.** Pray 1 Timothy 2:1-4 aloud. Pray for our President, Congress, and Governor. Pray for our county leaders, city leaders, and school board. Read Romans 13:1-6. Pray that God will give us wisdom on how to honor our leaders without ever disobeying His Word.
- ☐ **Day 5: Our Church Leadership.** Pray Hebrews 13:17-18 aloud. Pray for our pastors, staff, and Dream Team (volunteer) leaders. Pray that God would protect them from temptation and poor decisions. Pray for discernment, integrity, wisdom, vision and sensitivity to what God wants to do.

- ☐ **Day 6: Our Families.** Pray Psalm 127:3-5 aloud. Pray for your family. Pray for families and marriages in our church. Pray for families in our community and the sanctity of marriage in our nation. Pray that God will heal broken families and the hurt that comes in the midst of that brokenness.
- ☐ **Day 7: The Spiritual Battle.** Pray 2 Corinthians 10:3-6 aloud. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you where the Enemy is working in your heart, thinking, family, city, and church. Bind and rebuke his efforts in the name of Jesus. Firmly declare the life, truth, and Word of God over each situation.
- ☐ **Day 8: The Power of The Spirit.** Pray Acts 1:8 and John 16:7-11 aloud. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you greater wisdom, gifts, and power to do His will. Pray that God will increase the power and work of the Holy Spirit in our church. Pray that we all will be attentive to His direction and in step with His Spirit in all things.
- ☐ **Day 9: Strife, Fear, Disunity.** Pray Joshua 1:9 aloud. Ask God to bring an end to the strife, fear, and disunity in our nation. Pray that He would keep it out of your home and far from our church. Pray that your life and our church will be places of peace, courage, unity and blessing.
- ☐ **Day 10: Youth and the Future.** Pray 1 Timothy 4:12 aloud. Pray over children's and youth ministries at our church. Pray Jeremiah 29:11 over our young people. Pray for protection, courage, and faith in our young people. Pray that God will raise up amazing leaders to lead the next generations.
- ☐ **Day 11: Health and Healing.** Pray Jeremiah 30:17 aloud. Pray for the people you know who are sick and need healing. Pray that disease, death, and suicide will be pushed back from our city. Pray that the Holy Spirit would bring miraculous healing in our church to the glory of God the Father.

- ☐ **Day 12: Favor.** Pray Psalm 90:17 aloud. Pray that God would give you favor to minister and bring life to places others cannot reach. Pray that God opens doors for our church that only He can open. Pray that God will grant us favor in our community and that every bit of it would be used to advance God's Kingdom and bring glory to Jesus.

- ☐ **Day 13: The Lost.** Pray 2 Peter 3:9 aloud. Pray for family members and friends you know who don't know Jesus. Pray for their hearts to be opened by God's Spirit. Pray for Words and strategy from the Holy Spirit on how you can be used to reach them. Pray that our church will see a large number of people come to Jesus and grow in Him.

- ☐ **Day 14: Our Church.** Pray Hebrews 10:24-25. Pray that God would protect, bless, and use our church. Pray that He always has His way there. Pray that people would encounter God during our services. Pray that we would be good stewards of the resources and people He has brought to us. Pray for unity, love, and power in and through the ministry. Pray that leaders and ministry would be multiplied and released beyond our current limitations. Pray for His vision.

- ☐ **Day 15: The Church Throughout the World.** Pray Psalm 22:27-28 aloud. Pray for the persecuted Christians throughout the world. Pray for their protection and for their leaders. Pray for the nations that seem to have turned away from Jesus. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you a specific nation to pray for and pray for them. Pray that God will raise up world-wide evangelists and workers of the harvest.

- ☐ **Day 16: Social Ills.** Pray John 10:10 and Proverbs 11:10 aloud. Pray against crime, drugs, and violence in our area and nation. Pray for peace, order, righteousness, and healing. Pray against abortion and human trafficking. Pray healing on those who have been involved with it. Pray against racism, poverty, and injustice.

- ☐ **Day 17: Personal and World Peace.** Pray John 14:27 aloud. Ask God to increase your peace no matter what goes on around you. Pray that you can minister His peace to others who need it. Pray for an ending to war, terrorism and bloodshed. Pray for the peace of Israel.

- ☐ **Day 18: Strongholds and Breakthrough.** Pray Isaiah 61:1-3 aloud. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal spiritual strongholds in your life, the hearts of your family members, and our church. Pray that God would tear them down, open eyes, and bring forth His freedom. Pray that people you encounter and people who are touched by our ministries find genuine and lasting freedom and breakthrough.

- ☐ **Day 19: Wisdom and Understanding.** Pray James 1:5 and Jeremiah 33:2-3 aloud. Pray that God would give you wisdom and understanding to navigate the challenges of our times. Pray for discernment in the things we hear and wisdom in the voices we listen to. Pray that we will take the path of wisdom and righteousness regardless of what is expected of us.

- ☐ **Day 20: Provision and Blessing.** Pray 2 Corinthians 9:8 aloud. Pray that God will provide all that you need to accomplish His will. Pray for an abundance that you can share with others. Pray that God will supply for all the needs and work of our church and that we steward it all well for His glory.

- ☐ **Day 21: Jesus' Return.** Pray 2 Peter 3:11-13 aloud. Pray for revival. Pray that the Gospel will be preached throughout the world, and that a great harvest will result. Pray that God will prepare us for our heavenly home and bring the Church to it soon!
