Save the date for an afternoon retreat for all women on Sunday, Aug. 30, at 12:30 on Lake Washington.

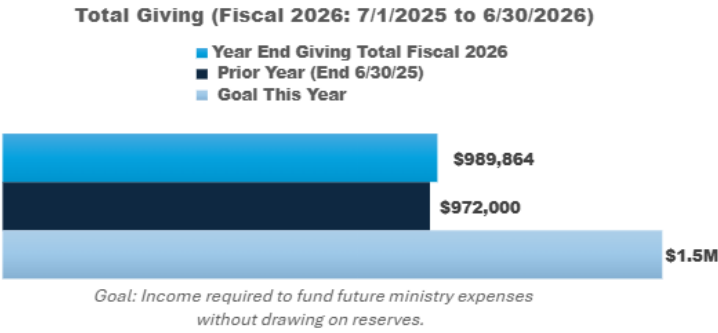
