SERMON NOTES

“The Dreams of Old Men” Joel 2:27-32

Intro: [Acts 19:1-2] “We did not even know there was a Holy Spirit”
Pentecost (50 days after Passover)—1st fruits/10 C's/Giving Holy Spirit
Peter's Joel 2 reference on first post-Easter Pentecost

I. Power

A. Joel's promise has broad reach

1. Extends God's grace beyond Israel [v28; S Is 49:6, Jn 3:16]
2. Men and women, the young and the old
3. “Even on male and female servants I will pour out my Spirit in those days. [v29]
4. “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be delivered. [v32; Acts 2:21]

B. You are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. [Rom 8:9]

—The rub: how to know if the Spirit lives within us. Bathroom stall certainty

1. Transforming into His image [2 Cor 3:17-18]
2. Fruit as mentioned in a recent sermon [Gal 5:22-25]
3. Gifts: “To each . . . for the benefit of all. [1 Cor 12:4-11]

II. Passport

A. “Those ...led by the Spirit of God are the children of God.” [Rom 8:14]

1. “The Spirit himself intercedes for us with inexpressible groanings.” [v26-27]
2. “The Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, ‘Abba, Father.’” [v15]

B. Our Inheritance

1. “Sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession” [Eph 1:13-14; also 2 Cor 5:5]
2. No longer orphans [Jn 14:15-17, 25-27; Rom 8:23]

III. Peril

A. Simon Magus and the art of the deal [Acts 8:14-20]

1. Don't quench the Spirit [1 Th 5:19], don't grieve the Spirit [Eph 4:30]
2. Blasphemy against the Spirit [Lk 12:10]

B. Ananias and Sapphira [Acts 5:1-11]—Don't lie to the Spirit!

Conc: Ps 51:4, 10-12. Conviction of sin and desire for God
