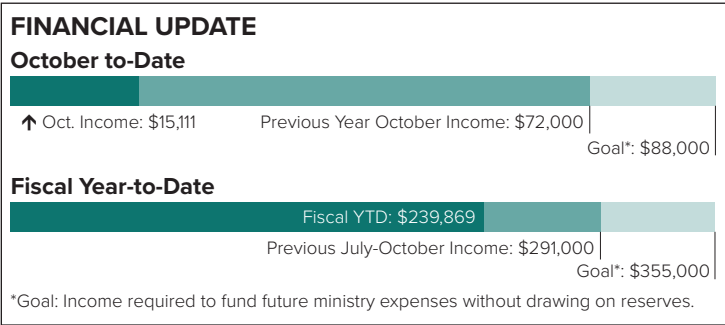


CELEBRATION SUNDAY - NOVEMBER 2
