KEEPING UP WITH OUR MISSIONARIES

Throughout the summer we will be updating you on our missionaries around the world.

Michael McLaughlin

Michael grew up at West Side and now serves as the Northwest Regional Director for the Christian Medical and Dental Association (CMDA), based in Portland. He oversees student groups on 10 healthcare campuses across Washington and Oregon, regularly meeting with students and

staying closely connected to the doctors who volunteer as campus advisors. He writes, "These docs are my boots on the ground, my mentors for the students," as he listens to their concerns and helps guide a new generation of biblically untrained and culturally immersed students.

Each year, Michael organizes the CMDA West Coast Regional Conference at Cannon Beach, which last year welcomed 210 attendees, including 55 students and residents. He also holds 40 to 50 personal meetings annually with student leaders, advisors, and physicians—spaces where he says the most meaningful ministry often happens, "whether through coaching, counseling, sharing resources, or simply listening and encouraging one another in faith and service."

Michael's work continues to shape future healthcare professionals through mentorship, discipleship, and deep relational investment.
