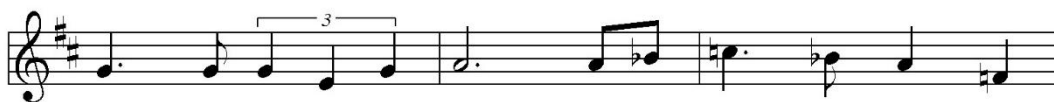

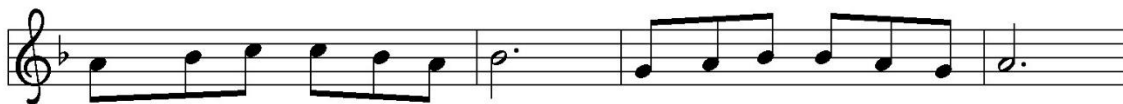

+ SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM +

INTRODUCTION


